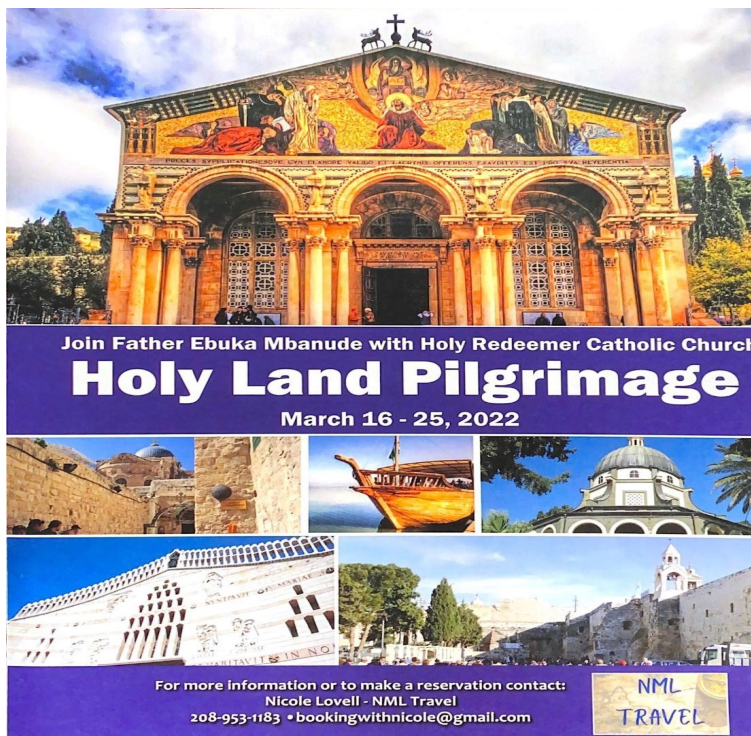

Please plan to attend in order to receive information and paperwork in preparation for this sacrament.

Our Exodus 90 Fraternity at HR Parish continues with "Decision Dome".

"Decision Dome" is a 42 day spiritual exercise for men that will begin on Sunday September 26, 2021. The program is based on 3 pillars: prayer, asceticism, and fraternity which are all important aspects of the Christian life.

For this exercise, we will read the Book of Joshua and see how the Israelite people struggled to stay faithful to the Lord after Moses's death in the wilderness. Men who join the program will commit and strive to take on the following spiritual disciplines: Spend 20 minutes of silent contemplative prayer each day; Abstain from meat on Fridays; Fast until 4 P.M. on Fridays; Abstain from complaining; Abstain from mobile device use in front of others; Abstain from non-essential purchases of all sorts; Make your bed; Get a full night's sleep (at least 7 hours is recommended); Make a nightly examen; and Check in with your anchor (friend doing the program) each day.

Our Fraternity meets weekly on Wednesday mornings from 5:30-6:30 AM in the Church basement with the option to come early at 5:10 AM for the recitation of the Holy Rosary.
