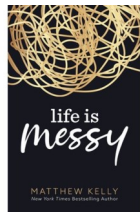

At Home Marriage Retreat for National Marriage Week 2023

The observances of National Marriage Week (Feb. 7-14) and World Marriage Day (Sunday, Feb. 12) are an opportunity to focus on building a culture of life and love that begins with supporting and promoting marriage and the family. This year's theme, "Marriage... one flesh, given and received" highlights the one-flesh union of husband and wife that is willed by God. It also indicates the personal selfgift of each spouse, one to the other. These concepts point to Christ who gives Himself under the appearance of bread and wine—as real flesh and blood. In honor of the week-long celebration which recognizes and affirms the Sacrament of Marriage, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has released a seven-day At-Home Marriage Retreat for couples to deepen their couple prayer and enrich their marriage. Each day's retreat may be as short as a half-hour or it may become a day-long dialogue. The outline for each day begins with a short reflection on a different habit proposed for the couple to develop. Each habit is then reviewed first from the perspective of the couple's relationship with Christ and then through the lens of the couple's own relationship. The retreat is a perfect opportunity for couples to unite in prayer and reflection. Praying together as a couple can strengthen the bond between husband and wife as well as increase trust and intimacy between one another. More important, it is an intentional way for spouses to invite the Lord into their marriage and acknowledge God's presence in their relationship.
