Holy Redeemer's **PreK Program** has a few openings in its **Half Day 3 year olds** classes for the coming school year; 2, 3 or 5 half days per week.

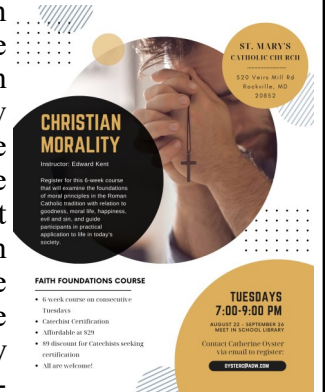
