July 20 - 26, 2025: National NFP Awareness Week

Promote Natural Family Planning during the week of July 20 – 26. The dates of Natural Family Planning Awareness Week highlight the anniversary of the Saint Pope Paul VI's encyclical Humanae Vitae (July 25) which articulates Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, conjugal love, and responsible parenthood. On July 26, the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, we invite engaged and married couples to join the Office of Family Life for a virtual introduction to the science and spirituality of Natural Family Planning to learn more about Fertility Awareness Based Methods.
