**Pentecost Sunday: COME, HOLY SPIRIT.** In the Old Testament, Pentecost (God's Spirit) was a major Jewish feast, recalling God's giving the Law to Moses. Awesome signs accompanied the appearance of Yahweh to Moses to establish the Covenant. Fast forward to the New Testament, Pentecost Sunday marks the birth of the Church, the beginning of the New Covenant. As the Spirit came to these followers of Jesus, they were being commissioned to go out and proclaim the Gospel. Their gifts of tongues reversed the Tower of Babel scene (Gen 11:1-9). There the one language was divided into many; on Pentecost the many languages represented were united into one by the intervention of God. For us Christians today, Pentecost is extremely important, the Holy Spirit gives life to the Church, our church and lead us to the call of God our father, and to God, anything in the Name of Jesus, his Son.
