The Most Holy Trinity: ONE GOD, THREE PERSONS. Faith in the Blessed Trinity is central to the Christian religion. It is impossible to be a Christian and not believe in the Trinity. Yet, it is a profound mystery. Before Jesus, the descendants of Abraham had held that there is only One God. Then Jesus came as God's only begotten Son. We see him as the second person of the blessed Trinity. After Jesus returned to Heaven, He and the Father sends the Holy Spirit whom we know as the third person of the Blessed Trinity. Not surprisingly, it took the church some time to clarify its teaching concerning the Blessed Trinity. There is a lot of Trinitarian texts in the New Testament. Possibly, the clearest text is in the Gospel of Matthew 28:19, "Baptize them (all nations) in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit". We call it the Baptismal formula. Amen.
