

The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ: ONE BREAD, ONE BODY. First Corinthians is the earliest literary account of the institution of the Holy Eucharist, coming some ten years before any Gospel was composed. Paul, writing from the city of Ephesus about AD55, where he observed improper observance of the Eucharist to counteract these situations, especially the divisions in the community, he wrote Jesus body and blood was given for our salvation and whenever they gather the Eucharist must be their way of regularly sharing in the meal of the Risen One. (1 Corinthians 11:26) ...for as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the death of our Lord until he comes". This is also an eschatological thrust. So, our sharing in the Eucharist unites us to Jesus in this life but also makes it possible for us to share in the glory of Jesus when he returns at the end of times. Amen.
