19th Sunday in Ordinary Time: BE AWARE; BE VIGILANT:

Jesus imparts two critical lessons to us, his followers in today's Gospel. Since the Father has given the Kingdom to the disciple, Jesus wants their hearts to be the kingdoms treasure, and not possessions. In a loving way he calls them "little flocks" (Luke 12:32) and urges them to use their possessions as alms (gifts). The other important teaching of Jesus is the absolute necessity of preparing for his Second Coming, for the Eschatological Judgement. This coming back is definite, but the time is not known, therefore, says Christ, be watchful; be prepared; be faithful to the very end. Vigilant and fruitful servants will be rewarded. Amen
