25th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Today's reading highlights two key themes: stewardship and shrewdness, and the choice to serve God or wealth. The parable of the unjust steward uses a dishonest manager to illustrate how "children of this age" use worldly resources wisely to secure their future. Jesus uses this example to challenge believers, "children of light," to apply similar prudence in managing their earthly resources, not for earthly gain, but to store up treasure in heaven by generously sharing them, thus preparing for their heavenly future.
