26th Sunday in Ordinary Time Today's reading teaches about the irreversible consequences of how we treat others, highlighting the reversal of fortunes between the rich man and Lazarus after death and emphasizing that God's word, not a miracle from the dead, is sufficient to lead to repentance. The parable uses the suffering of the rich man and the comfort of Lazarus to illustrate that a life lived without regard for the poor will lead to torment, while a life of faith and generosity is rewarded in God's kingdom. It underscores the spiritual importance of compassion, even for those we don't know, and serves as a stark warning against indifference to the needy.
