

Dear Friends,

Joie. Alegria. Áthas. Gioia. 즐거움. Kagalakan. 喜び.

There are many ways we can say "joy." I could go on, with hundreds of different ways to say, to speak joy.

Gaudete Sunday, the "pink" Sunday we know so well, is the reprieve in the four weeks of our Advent journey. It is a joyous reminder that even amid the work of conversion in this Advent season, our journey is always walked in joy.

In one sense, we cannot use the word "joy" enough during our liturgy today. We say it in every form: joyous, joy, rejoice...

Yet Gaudete Sunday is more than "saying" joy or speaking the word. This day is about learning to live it, and live it fully. We as Christians are called to be joyous journeyers. We as Christians are called to be rejoicing disciples. Joy is not what we say. It is what we do and how we live. That can be a daunting task in a world that seems to consume joy for its breakfast. It's easy to become overwhelmed, bitter, angry, impatient, afraid. The world we live in, for some reason, values these feelings and qualities more. But Christians are invited into joy.

Pope Francis speaks about joy often. He reminds us that every day, every interaction we have with others is an opportunity to share Christ's joy with others. So say it. Speak it. And live it.
