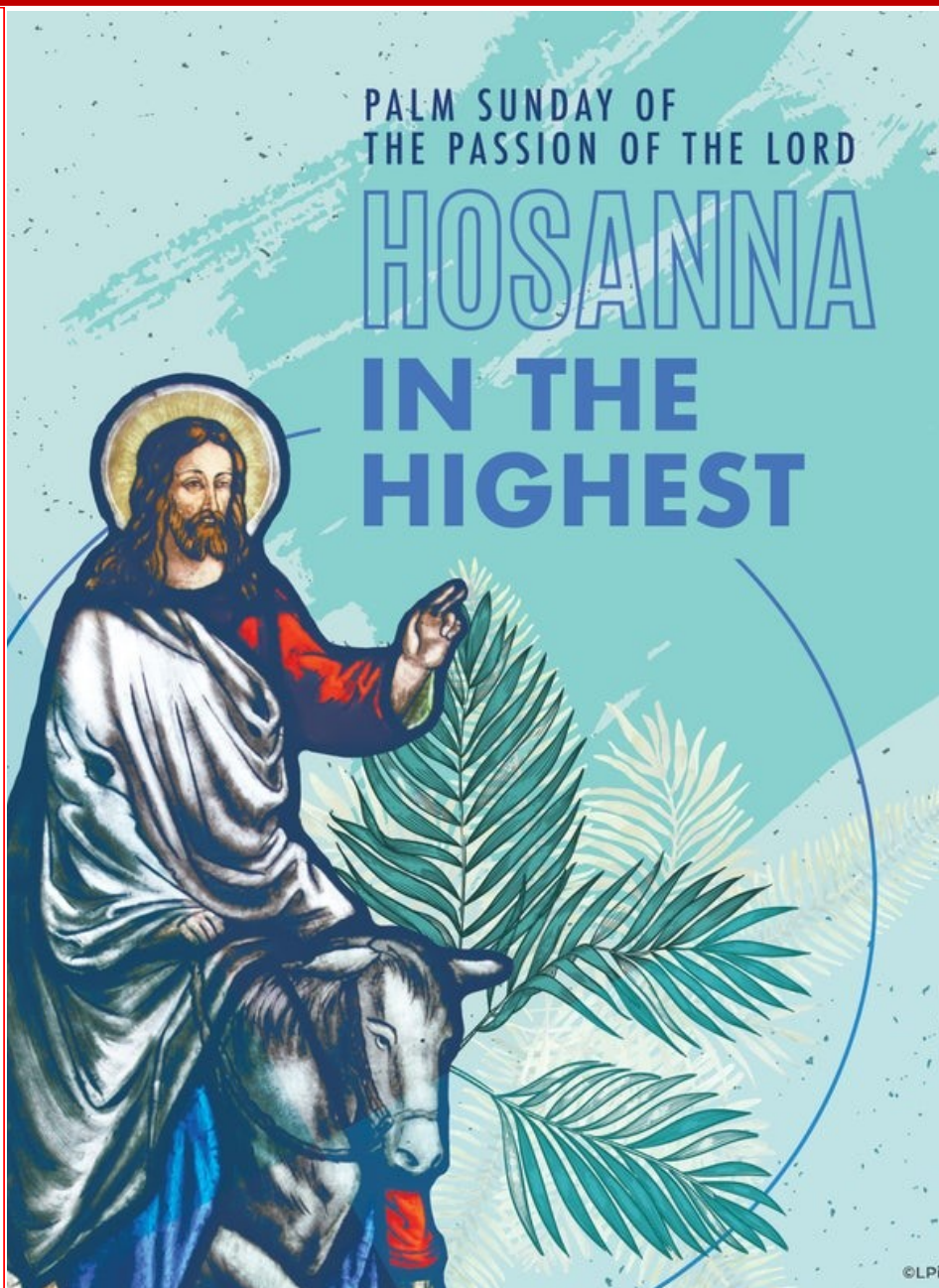

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Fix Me, Jesus” is an African American spiritual I’ve encountered within the last year. There are different versions of this spiritual, but plea is present within the song, no matter how it is sung:

O, fix me, Jesus, fix me right.
Fix me right, fix me right;
O, fix me, Jesus, fix me right,
Fix me so I can stand.

This Lenten season we have focused on the journey to the cross. This journey is one taken intentionally. Too often we might think that our Christian path is one of mere self-betterment. Yet the journey to the cross is not an individual one. It is not just about me or what I’ve accomplished. It is about my relationship with Jesus.

We walk this journey to the cross with the plea: Fix me Jesus, fix me, that we might become closer to Jesus Christ, the crucified and risen one. We seek wholeness not in some remedy within the world, but within the person of Christ.

This Palm Sunday, we make this journey from cries of Hosanna to the cries at the foot of the cross yet one more time. We do this as faithful disciples of the one who gives us everything that we might know God’s healing love and divine touch in our own lives. The journey to the cross is not an easy one, but on the way, let us cry out to God: O, fix me, fix me Jesus.
