



BAPTISM PREPARATION SESSION

The next preparation session for the celebration of Baptism will be held on August 19th, and Baptisms will take place at the 5:30 Mass on Saturday, August 26th, or the 7:30 am, and 10:00 am Masses on Sunday, August 27th. Baptism is also offered in Spanish at the 12:00 Noon Mass. Please contact Barbara Stanton for more information at bstanton@archdpdx.org or 503-252-3403 x104 to make an appointment to fill out the application for your child's Baptism and review the policy for having your child baptized at St. Rita. Please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate to this appointment.

FAITH FORMATION AND SACRAMENT PREPARATION

Forms for Faith Formation, grades K – 5th; First Eucharist and First Confession, grades 2nd and older, and Confirmation, grades 7 – 12 are currently on our website at stritapdx.org. We also have a new process for Confirmation. PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING POLICY: Confirmation Preparation is now a two-year process at St. Rita. Year 1 or Pre-Confirmation Class consists of 6th and 7th grades. Year 2 or Confirmation Class Proper consist of grades 7 to 12.

We also require a copy of your child's baptism certificate if he/she was not baptized at St. Rita Church and is preparing for First Reconciliation/ First Eucharist, or Confirmation. The certificate must be submitted before your child can start the sacrament programs. August 13, 2023 - 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

A man at my parish was struggling to overcome a habitual sin. He said to me, "Father, I know the chance that I will commit sin again is really high. Why should I keep confessing my sins? Isn't that dishonest?" Anyone who has felt the tyrannical power of sin — and who hasn't? — has pondered this kind of question.

I responded to him, "What was the probability Peter would walk on the stormy water?" After some silence, he said, "Zero. But when Jesus called, he did it." I could tell my penitent friend was re-framing the question from his own weakness to the greatness of the Lord's love for him. The question for us should not be one of human probabilities about our sin, but rather whether or not we will trust the Lord's grace in our lives.

This week the Lord is calling you and me to do the impossible: overcome sin with love. The only way to do that is to trust he is calling, and then to walk with the eyes of faith locked on him. And if we sink, he will raise us up again and again. Of that, we can be 100% sure.

13 de agosto de 2023 - 19º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Este pasaje de Mateo nos lleva a reflexionar sobre la importancia de la fe y de cómo la profesamos a lo largo de nuestra vida. Desarrollar la fe es un proceso que da comienzo el día de nuestro bautismo. En ese momento fue plantada la semilla de la fe. Ya de adultos, escuchar la Palabra de Dios nos ayuda a enfrentar las tormentas cotidianas. A veces se tambalea nuestra fe. Pareciera que nada vale la pena y es cuando acudimos al Señor, como Pedro en el Evangelio, y viene el grito de: ¡Sálvame, Señor! de la incertidumbre, del miedo y de la falta de paz en nuestras ciudades, en las familias y en

nuestros corazones. A pesar de nuestra poca fe, queremos ser fieles a Jesús y sus enseñanzas. Solo él puede salvarnos.

Aunque vacile a causa de mis debilidades, tómame de tu mano y llévame hacia ti. Porque tú no eres un fantasma, eres el Hijo de Dios. Eres quien me tranquiliza, me da paz y serenidad para discernir, con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, lo mejor para salvarme, para salvarnos en familia, en comunidad. Para eso tenemos su Palabra y la Iglesia que nos ayuda y guía en todos los tiempos. "Cerca está su salvación de los que le temen y habitará su Gloria en nuestra tierra. La Gracia y la Verdad se han encontrado, la Justicia y la Paz se han abrazado; de la tierra está brotando la verdad, y del cielo se asoma la justicia" (Salmo 85:10-12). La meta de este domingo de fe, es siempre confiar en el Señor y no en nosotros mismos.


