



BAPTISM PREPARATION SESSION

The next preparation session for the celebration of Baptism will be held on Saturday, September 16th, 10:00 am, in the Religious Education Center. Baptisms will take place at the 5:30 Mass on Saturday, September 23rd, or the 7:30 am, and 10:00 am Masses on Sunday, September 24th. Baptism is also offered in Spanish at the Sunday 12:00 Noon Mass.

FAITH FORMATION AND SACRAMENT PREPARATION

Forms for Faith Formation, grades K – 5th; First Eucharist and First Confession, grades 2nd and older, and Confirmation, grades 6 - 12 are currently on our website at stritapdx.org. PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING POLICY: Confirmation Preparation is now a two-year process at St. Rita. Year 1 or Pre -Confirmation Class consists of 6th and 7th grades. Year 2 or Confirmation Class Proper consist of grades 7 to 12. We also require a copy of your child's baptism certificate if he/she was not baptized at St. Rita Church and is preparing for First Reconciliation/ First Eucharist, or Confirmation. If you have children who will be attending Faith Formation sessions or Preparation for First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Eucharist (Holy Communion) please mark your calendars for the following meeting. September 3, 2023 - 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isn't it easy to relate to Peter? One moment Jesus announces Peter's deep communion with God the Father. The very next, when he rejects the logic of Jesus' suffering and death, Jesus calls Peter Satan. We Christians shouldn't be too shocked when we experience both spiritual highs and lows, when we perceive breathtaking contradictions in our hearts.

Like the great apostle, you and I are recipients of unfathomable graces. God dwells in us, calls his beloved children, and takes care of our every need. And we also continually fail to embrace our sufferings with trust in Jesus. We know the truth of the creed, but we easily scorn the weight of the cross.

The good news is that, like Peter, we are never abandoned by the Lord even at our worst moments. Peter will eventually learn the beauty of the cross when he is willingly crucified. But it took time for him to get there. And it takes time for us, too. This week let's not be too shocked at these divisions in our hearts but accept them and patiently seek to be more obedient to Jesus' cross-shaped plan for us.

3 de septiembre de 2023 22° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

La Liturgia de hoy muestra cómo el maligno había entrado en el corazón de Pedro, y cómo fue reprendido por Jesús, por estar fuera de la voluntad del Padre. Así es nuestra vida, no podemos descuidar la voluntad de Dios, porque inmediatamente estaremos cambiando de pensamiento y obra. Para estar del lado de Dios, hace falta una profunda conversión personal y comunitaria. Apartados de su amor, es imposible ser justos y mucho menos ser testigos de su Palabra y dar testimonio de su amor. Hoy, se nos presenta el reto de conocer a profundidad la misión de Jesús y la de sus seguidores.

Ser cristiano comprometido tiene su condición y su consecuencia: "El compromiso de tomar la cruz se convierte en participación con Cristo en la salvación del mundo. Pensando en esto, hagamos que la cruz colgada en la pared de la casa, o esa pequeña que llevamos al cuello, sea signo de nuestro deseo de unirnos a Cristo en el servir con amor a los hermanos, especialmente a los más pequeños y frágiles. La cruz es signo santo del Amor de Dios, es signo del Sacrificio de Jesús, y no debe ser reducida a objeto supersticioso o joya ornamental" (Papa Francisco 08/30/2020). ¿Qué piensas de este mensaje que dice el Papa Francisco? Crees que vale la pena perder la vida por Jesús y su misión de propagar su Reino a pesar de las circunstancias. Vivir de manera decidida por el Evangelio causa lo que el Señor dijo en su Bienaventuranza: "Felices ustedes, cuando por causa mía los insulten, los persigan y les levanten toda clase de calumnias..." (Mateo 5:11).






