



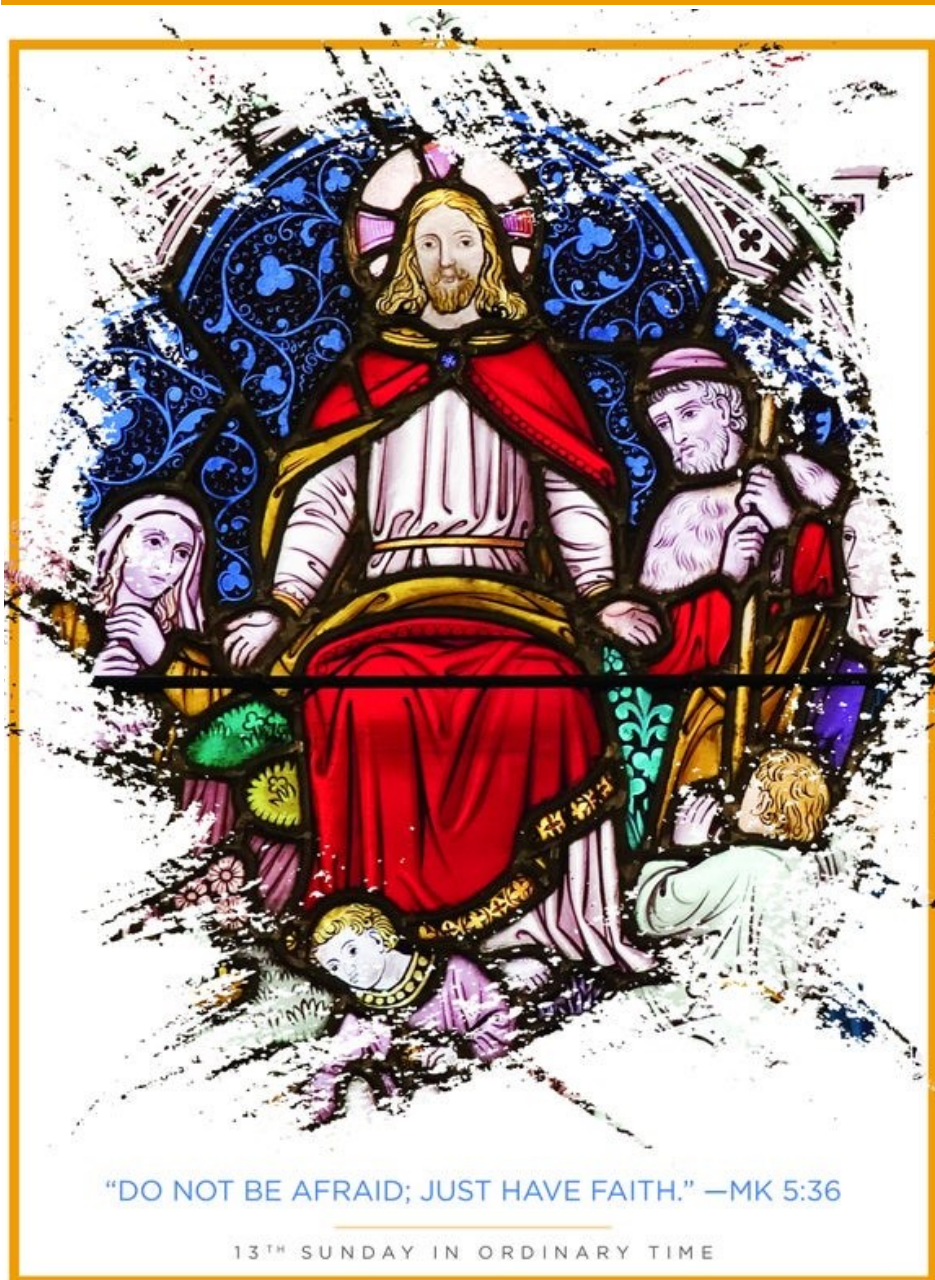

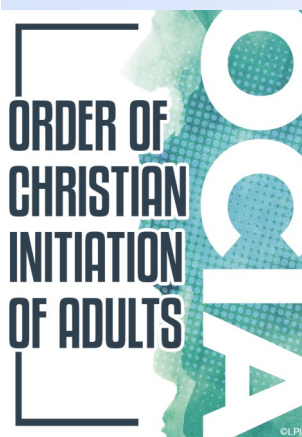

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sin isn't given its due these days. Downplaying sin is dangerous. But there is also another spiritual misstep in which we make way too big a deal out of sin. It happens, for example, when we persistently wonder if our confessed sins are "really" forgiven, or suspiciously ponder what God "really" thinks about us, behind His merciful face. Or when someone returns to Church, and we question whether his or her conversion was genuine. Or when we commit some sin and put on a sad face for days, thinking, "Maybe my sins are too great for God to deal with." God save us from that attitude!

Well, he does just that, this week, in the raising of Jairus' daughter. The dead twelve-year-old's house is filled with a spirit of excessive moaning and groaning, tumultuous weeping and wailing. They even laugh at Jesus in a mocking tone. It's shocking how easy it is for him to raise the dead child. It is equivalent to gently waking a kid from a light nap. And then he sends her off to get some lunch. No big whoop. The overactive drama is actually part of the problem, and removing it is a key part of the miracle. Friends, sin can and does kill, but Jesus is always ready and able to raise us back to life, often without much hullabaloo. His ease of forgiving should never be a pretext for presumption, minimizing sin, or taking lightly the cost he pays for our sins on the cross. But for God's sake, we often need Jesus to put out the weepers and wailers. He's the Lord. And remember, the girl is not dead, she's just sleeping.

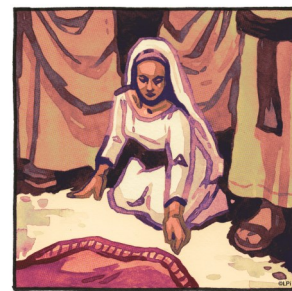

## MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

### 13° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

El Evangelio de hoy nos narra las historias de dos mujeres, una mayor y una niña, unidas por el dolor de la enfermedad. Una de ellas fue curada por su gran fe, y la pequeña, al tomarla Jesús de la mano, volvió a la vida. A la mayoría de las personas les da pavor el pensar que están enfermas y peor aún que pueden morir. ¿Qué podemos decir a tanta persona enferma y triste? ¿Cómo podemos consolarlas en sus tribulaciones? Una manera es acompañarlas y escucharlas, estar con ellas mostrándoles interés y ayudarlas en sus necesidades. Otra forma es tomando el ejemplo de la mujer que buscó y se acercó a Jesús para ser curada. Busquemos a Jesús con la misma fe que ella lo hizo. Venció los obstáculos del miedo y de la distancia y tocó su manto. Sólo Dios puede y tiene el poder de sanar nuestros corazones y renovar nuestra vida.



Jesús pasó su vida haciendo el bien, curando y perdonando, y siempre al final de sus milagros daba una recomendación. A la mujer enferma le dijo: "*Hija, tu fe te ha salvado; vete en paz y queda sana de tu enfermedad*" (Marcos 5:34). Y a la pequeña: "*Tomándola de la mano, dijo a la niña: Talitá kumi, que quiere decir: Niña, te lo digo, ¡levántate! ... y les dijo que dieran algo de comer a la niña*" (Marcos 5:41-43). No se ha terminado el tiempo de los milagros, sigue en pie, solo que ahora nos toca a nosotros los bautizados seguir haciéndolos. ¿Cómo? Sencillamente, compartiendo lo que tenemos y acompañando de corazón a los que sufren a nuestro alrededor.
