







4th Sunday of Advent — Enter Love

Dear Parishioners,

As we reach the final Sunday of Advent, the nearness of Christmas becomes unmistakable. The wreath is nearly full with light, the Scriptures grow quieter and more intimate, and the promise we have been waiting for stands at the threshold.

In this final week, our attention turns to Joseph. His story is often quiet, easily overlooked beside angelic choirs and the unexpected visit of shepherds who come from the fields. But Joseph reveals something essential about love: it is more than feeling. No. Love is fidelity, trust, and courageous faithfulness. When Joseph learns that Mary is to bear a child through the Holy Spirit, Matthew tells us he is a "righteous man." His first instinct is mercy. His discernment takes place in prayer, not in haste. And when God speaks through the angel, Joseph listens not just with his ears, but with his life.

Over and over, we are reminded that love enters the world through people willing to say yes. Mary's "yes" welcomed the Incarnation. Joseph's "yes" protected it. Our "yes" allows that same love to be born again in our homes, our relationships, and our world.

As we light the final candle on the Advent wreath, we are reminded that God's love is not distant or abstract. It has a name, a face, and a heartbeat. The God who formed galaxies has chosen to come among us as a child in need of welcome.

May this final week of waiting soften our hearts, steady our hope, deepen our peace, awaken our joy, and prepare us to allow love to enter. The name of this love is Emmanuel: God with us.

Cuarto domingo de Adviento: Llega el amor

Queridos feligreses:

Al llegar al último domingo de Adviento, la cercanía de la Navidad se hace inconfundible. La corona está casi llena de luz, las Escrituras se vuelven más serenas e íntimas, y la promesa que hemos estado esperando se encuentra en el umbral.

En esta última semana, nuestra atención se centra en José. Su historia suele ser silenciosa, fácilmente pasada por alto junto a los coros angelicales y la visita inesperada de los pastores que regresan del campo. Pero José revela algo esencial sobre el amor: es más que sentimiento. No. El amor es fidelidad, confianza y una fidelidad valiente. Cuando José se entera de que María dará a luz un hijo por obra del Espíritu Santo, Mateo nos dice que es un "hombre justo". Su primer instinto es la misericordia. Su discernimiento se produce en la oración, no con prisa. Y cuando Dios habla a través del ángel, José escucha no solo con sus oídos, sino con su vida.

Una y otra vez, se nos recuerda que el amor entra en el mundo a través de personas dispuestas a decir sí. El "sí" de María dio la bienvenida a la Encarnación. El "sí" de José la protegió. Nuestro "sí" permite que ese mismo amor renazca en nuestros hogares, nuestras relaciones y nuestro mundo.

Al encender la última vela de la corona de Adviento, recordamos que el amor de Dios no es distante ni abstracto. Tiene nombre, rostro y latido. El Dios que creó las galaxias ha elegido venir entre nosotros como un niño necesitado de acogida.

Que esta última semana de espera ablañe nuestros corazones, fortalezca nuestra esperanza, profundice nuestra paz, despierte nuestra alegría y nos prepare para dejar entrar el amor. El nombre de este amor es Emmanuel: Dios con nosotros.
