Frequently Asked Questions

How often Should on receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation?

Catholics should receive the Sacrament of Penance frequently or at very least after they've reached the age of reason, Catholics are obliged to confess their serious sins at least once a year (CIC 989). The regular practice of confession at least once a month is commended.

10 Commandments

- 1. I am the Lord your God. You shall not have strange gods before me.
- 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- 3. Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.
- 4. Honor your father and your mother.
- 5. You shall not kill.
- 6. You shall not commit adultery
- 7. You shall not steal.
- 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 9. You shall not desire your neighbor's wife.
- 10. You shall not desire your neighbor's goods.

What do I need to do in order to make a good Confession?

The sacrament consists of three actions on the part of the individual receiving the sacrament: sorrow for one's sins; examining one's conscience and telling one's sins to the priest; and penance, namely a desire to make up for one's sins and amend one's life.

How do I make an Examination of Conscience?

An Examination of Conscience is a review of one's thoughts, words, and actions. The use of the Ten Commandments can help us understand whether or not our thoughts, words, and actions are in line with Catholic teaching.

When and Where is the Sacrament of Confession available?
