Baptisms

Baptisms are held on the second and fourth Sunday of every month, following the 11:30 AM Mass. A two hour Baptism Prep Class is mandatory if it has been more than 4 years since your last child was baptized. Classes are held on the first Sunday of every month. Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

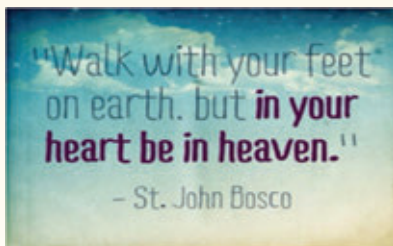

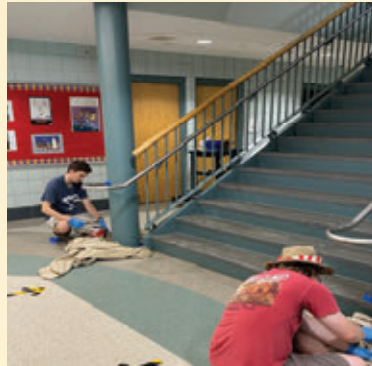
