Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

**Fast and Abstinence~
Acts of Penance for Lent**
Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022, on all the Fridays of Lent (with the exception of Friday, March 25, which is the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord) and Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

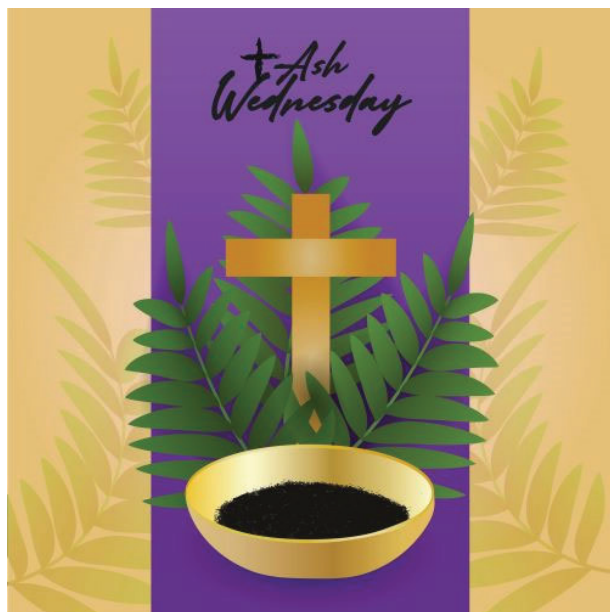
All the faithful are encouraged, when possible to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.

All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl which has aided countless hungry persons here in the Archdiocese as well as throughout our nation and our world.

The book of Hebrews is like a small catechism. It takes some of the theological truths of our Catholic Faith and draws connections between the Old Covenant and the New Testament teachings.

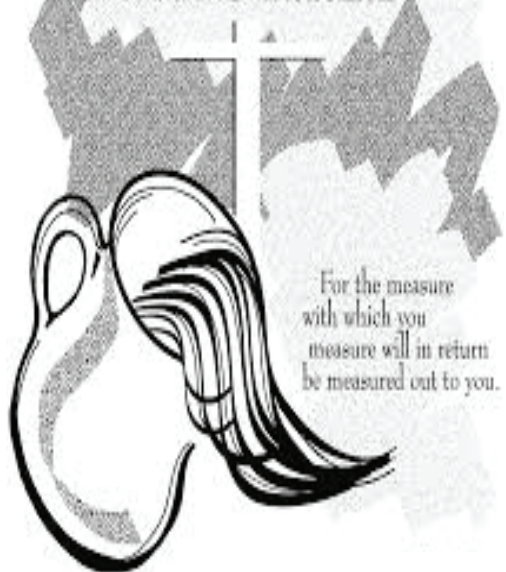

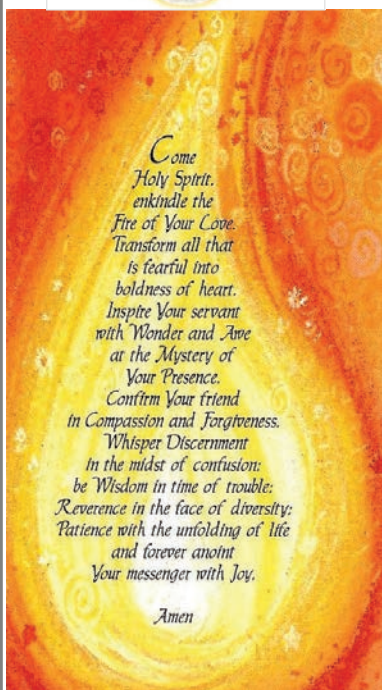
Dear Families,

In today's Gospel, Jesus continues to tell us that we should do the right thing even when it may be hard to do so. I would even go so far as to say, especially, when it is hard to do. It is better to be kind than, to be right. Give to others without expecting anything in return. We should love our enemies. Do good to those who hate us. Bless those who curse us. Pray for those who mistreat us. Be merciful, stop judging and condemning. Forgive and we will be forgiven. Give, and gifts will be given to us. "For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you."

For the craft below, you will need paper if you don't use the template, string or yarn, tape, scissors and crayons. You can cut out the cloud and hearts below or draw your own. If you draw your own, write the bible verse, God is merciful. Let's be merciful like our Lord Luke 6:27-38. In each heart write a way that we can be like God. You can take it from today's Gospel as shown below or give examples from your life. Once you have done this, tape the heart to the string on the side without words and then tape the other side of the string to the cloud taping it on the sign without writing. Repeat and then hang it somewhere to remind you to follow the Lord's lead.

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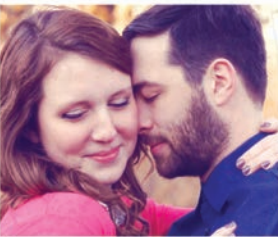
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
