Baptisms

A two hour Baptism Prep Class is mandatory if it has been more than 4 years since your last child was baptized. Classes are held on the first Sunday of every month. Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

Spiritual Adoption Program

Spiritual Adoption Program to pray for an unborn baby will begin in two weeks.

Everyone loves the beauty and innocence of a baby. As an expression of that love, the Respect Life Group at Saints Peter and Paul Parish will sponsor an adoption program in our parish on April 23,24. We will have the opportunity to spiritually adopt a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all newly conceived babies are allowed to be born. In fact, more than 2000 babies will lose their lives to abortion each day in the United States. It is these babies you are being asked to "adopt". You may adopt a child individually or as a family by simply picking up a prayer card after Mass during the weekend of April 23,24. Using the prayer on the back of the card, you will be asked to pray daily for 9 months for your unborn child and for all unborn children, for the power of prayer is great. You can name the child for whom you are praying, thereby giving the baby the humanity he or she deserves. There will be monthly reports in the bulletin describing your baby's development. There are millions of unborn babies desperately in need of your prayers. Won't you please spiritually adopt one and share the love for life that God has given you?

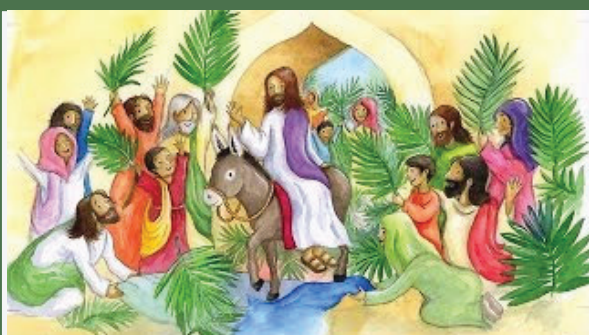

Dear Families,

As we begin the Holy Week, let's reflect on the many gifts that Jesus left us before He suffered, died and rose again for our sins so we may go to Heaven. At the Last Supper, Jesus had a special meal with his apostles. One which we celebrate at each Mass. At it and as we do today at Mass, He took a cup, gave thanks, and said, "Take this and share it among yourselves; for I tell you that from this time on I shall not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them,

saying, "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you. Let us not take for granted this gift of receiving Jesus in the Eucharist. When you hear these words at Mass, remember the Last Supper and His presence in the Eucharist.

Let's also try to be like Jesus when we go through difficult times and trust in God's plan. Jesus asked God the Father to take the burden away but only if it was God's will, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me; still, not my will but yours be done."

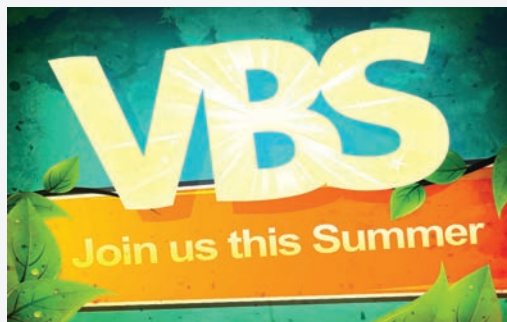

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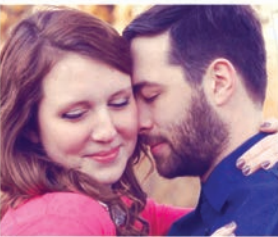
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
