Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

News from Fr. Reilly's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

In a multitude of different ways, Scripture tells us to place our hope in the Lord. For Isaiah, hope could be found in the restored Israel. Paul places his hope in the cross of Christ. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to rejoice that their names are written in heaven.

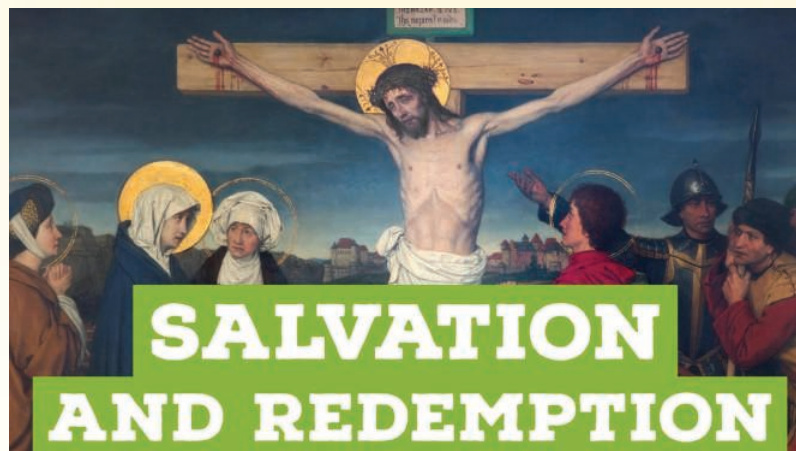
Although Isaiah wrote about two centuries before the Israelites were taken into captivity in Babylon, his prophetic vision points to their exile and return. In the passage from Isaiah we read, the exile was over, but Jerusalem had not yet been restored to its former glory. Isaiah assures them that the Lord will comfort them in Jerusalem. First Jerusalem, and then the Lord, are seen in metaphor as a mother with abundant milk to feed her children. She will carry them in her arms and hold them in her lap. We, too, are invited to rejoice in this image, imagining ourselves as the nurslings who will have our fill of milk and comfort in the arms of our loving God. We look forward to the fulfillment of this promise in heaven, the new Jerusalem, when we will be united with God for eternity.

Paul concludes his Letter to the Galatians by telling them that he wishes to never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is no longer circumcision or uncircumcision that sets God's people apart, but the marks of serving Christ. When we were baptized, we were marked for Christ with the sign of the cross. We were plunged into the waters of his death and drawn out as a new creation. Every time we make the sign of the cross, it reminds us to whom we belong. Christ suffered and died for us. As his followers, our lives will also be marked by suffering. If we are to boast in anything, let it be the cross.

In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus appoints seventy-two of his followers to share in both his mission and his power. In his name, they can cure illnesses and cast out demons. Yet he tells them not to rejoice because of this power, but because their names are written in heaven.

Like the disciples before us, we are invited to participate in Christ's mission for the salvation of souls to share in Christ's mission entails sharing in his suffering as well. If, like Paul, we bear the marks of our suffering for Christ, then he will recognize himself in us, when he comes again to judge the living and the dead. Let us rejoice and thank God for the gift of redemption and the opportunity of salvation which he won for us. May we have the strength to persevere until the end, so that we might claim our place in the new Jerusalem, comforted in the loving arms of God.

Adult Faith Formation

Have you thought about becoming Catholic?

Saints Peter and Paul Parish invites you to O.C.I.A.

The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults

Who is it for?

Anyone who is discerning becoming Catholic and would like to learn more about the Catholic Faith or anyone who has not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Holy Eucharist, Confirmation).

What does it involve?

Team members lead discussions and share their faith journeys with participants. Sessions are held Thursdays, from 6:30 to 8:00 PM in the Parish Center.

When do we begin?

A new group forms in May and meets with the team occasionally over the summer. Weekly sessions will begin Thursday, September 11 at 6:30 PM in the Parish Center. (Prior registration is necessary). Ideally, each candidate has been prayerfully discerning entry into the Christian Initiation process and has an interview with our pastor or Director of Faith Formation prior to the first weekly session.

July Poor Box Collection

St. Agnes Dorothy Day Room

Much of our parish Catholic missionary outreach to the poor and homeless in our local community is done through the St. Agnes Dorothy Day Room. The Day Room, which is located in a building at St. Agnes Church, provides extensive support to the disadvantaged in West Chester and nearby.

It provides a daily meal service, groceries, clothing, basic nursing services, health and wellness services, bilingual and educational outreach services, and other special programs for the poor, homeless and most vulnerable in our local community.

Last year, it served about 34,000 daily meals, and provided about 1,300 bags of groceries, 4,000 pieces of clothes, 2,700 packages of diapers and formula, and countless other services to the poor and needy.

Our parish doesn't provide those services, so those who live in our parish and local community who need them go to the Day Room to get them. Our parish, along with some other local parishes, in turn, provide support to the Day Room, so it can provide those services.

We support the Day Room through our Poor Box, the Manna Food Drive in May, the Partners in Outreach Easter Outfit drive, and the Christmas Tree Gift program. In addition, many of our parishioners volunteer there.

Although we provide a lot of support, the need is great. And the need has increased recently because of new restrictions imposed by the health department on the way daily meals are provided. In addition, renovations have become necessary to update the physical facility which has existed essentially in its original form for 33 years, even though the number of people served has grown significantly.

Please help as much as you can, first, through your prayers, and if you can, through a generous donation to this month's poor box. The poor, homeless and disadvantaged in our local community need our support.

Helping Other People Everyday HOPE

In the Gospel according to Saint Matthew (Matthew 25:45), Jesus tells us, "Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me."

The HOPE Ministry at Saints Peter and Paul Parish provides opportunities to reach out and to be of service to our homebound, seniors, or those in need in our parish community.

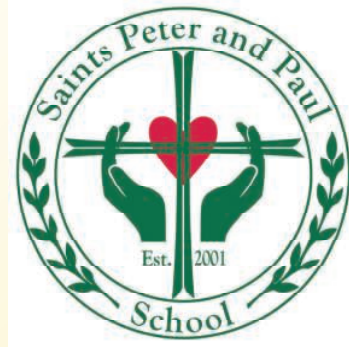

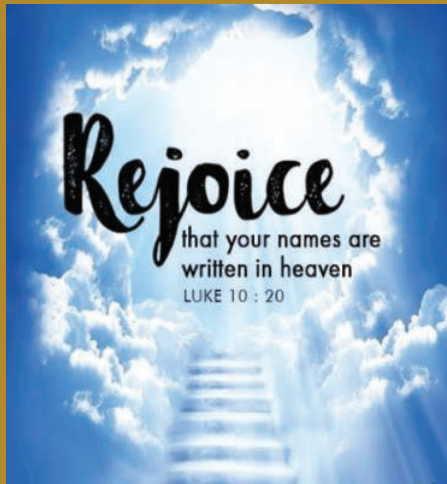

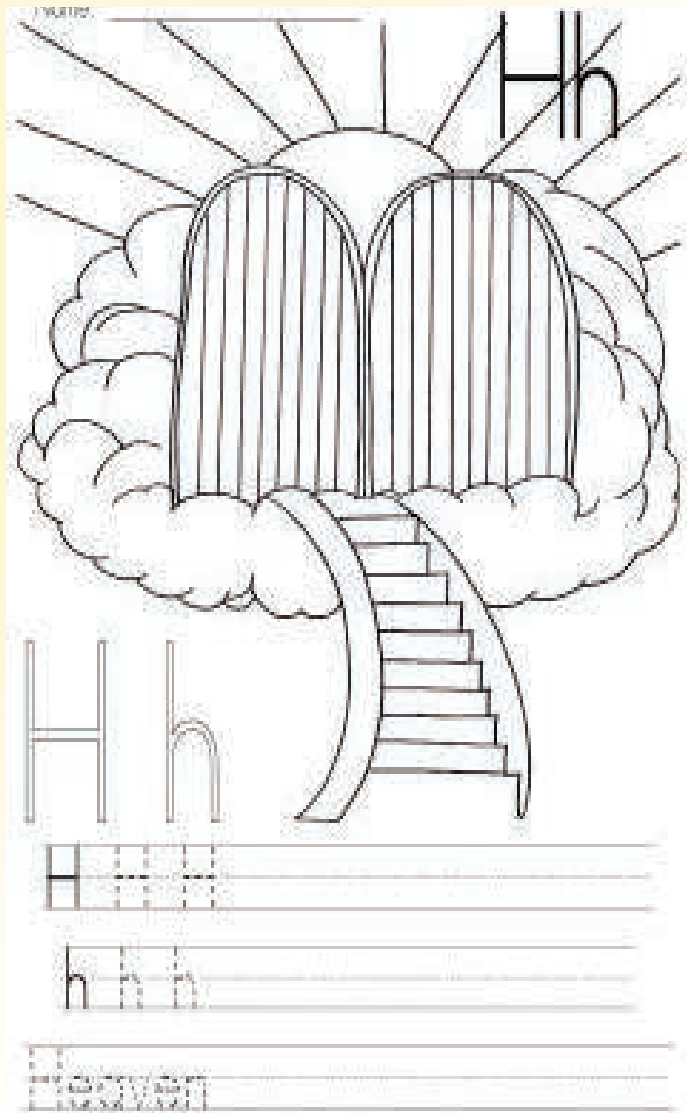
Dear Families,
