Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

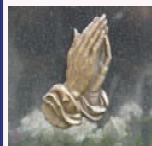

News from Fr. Reilly's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

In the book of Isaiah we hear about a darkness that covers the earth, and thick clouds that cover the peoples. The prophet Isaiah is speaking to God's people who had been overrun by their enemies, with survivors taken away into captivity and exile in Babylon. Certainly, they were feeling the weight and hopelessness of their collective situation. In our own time, we, too, can see circumstances in our community and our world that leave us feeling hopeless, as though a dark cloud were over us.

And yet, into these moments of darkness the prophet Isaiah speaks a word of hope. The glory of the Lord will once again shine on Jerusalem. This city that had been razed to the ground and plundered of all its riches will be rebuilt and made even more glorious than it was before. Isaiah describes the coming glory of Jerusalem, saying that this once devastated city will receive tribute from the ends of the earth and will be filled with the wealth of nations. Our God, who made all things from nothing, can restore all things, making them even better than they were before.

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. The word epiphany comes from a Greek word meaning "manifestation." Today's feast reminds us that in the birth of Christ, we have a manifestation that God's divine restoration plan is under way. Why do we have kings from distant lands coming to offer precious gifts to the Christ child in the manger? This is what Isaiah told us would accompany the time of Jerusalem's restoration: The riches of the sea shall be emptied out before you, the wealth of nations shall be brought to you . . . All from Sheba shall come bearing gold and frankincense. In other words, the Gospel is telling us that the time of our restoration has come.

Of course, we know that God's ultimate plan was not to rebuild a city. Rather, what God is doing is rebuilding his people from the inside out. By taking on our humanity in the Incarnation, Jesus draws us to share in his divinity. What we lost in the fall – grace, our likeness to God – is infinitely restored in Christ's coming among us. After the Incarnation, we don't just walk in relationship with God, we are taken up into the very life of God. Emmanuel, our God, comes to dwell with us and within us.

Today, let us give thanks to God for the hope we have – even in the midst of whatever current darkness we face because the time of God's restoration has come through the birth of Christ. As we wait for its ultimate realization in the fullness of his kingdom, we are fed by Christ and drawn more deeply into his divine life, rebuilding us into a people that will shine with his glory.

In commemoration of the visit of the Magi to the home of the Holy Family, there arose the custom of blessing homes during the week of Epiphany. The blessing includes marking the first initials of the legendary names of the Magi (Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar) at the top of the main door frame, along with the year, plus crosses in between the numbers and the letters. This year it would look like this:

20+C+M+B+26

The home of a Christian is a holy place ~ a place with Christian symbols and a place where prayers are said. On this feast of the Epiphany, whether you live alone or with a family, pray a blessing on the place you call home. Here's one to help you:

Be my shelter, Lord, when I am at home,
my companion when I am away, and my welcome guest when I return.

And at last receive me into the dwelling place
you have prepared for me in your Father's house,
where you live forever and ever.

Amen.

January Poor Box

Bournelyf Special Camp

The recipient of the January poor box is Bournelyf Special Camp, the only summer day camp of its kind in Chester County, providing outdoor recreational activities for individuals with intellectual & developmental disabilities ages 8 and up. The mission of the Camp is to develop participants' abilities by helping them build confidence, improve social and communication skills, and become more physically fit through challenging, but achievable physical activities and by interaction with others. Programs are offered for eight weeks during the summer (July-August) and throughout the year during monthly events held twice a month. Bournelyf is a nonprofit organization that relies on grants and donations to subsidize much of its operating costs.



Our Parish Ministry to the Homebound

Bethesda Project

Thank you for your great generosity to our homeless brothers and sisters, and especially for those who have given so abundantly through the Works of Mercy program. Over the past four months, our parish has delivered the following for the homeless served by Bethesda Project: Enough food for more than 1,200 meals (over 120 large casseroles, several frozen turkeys, hams, breads, rolls; over 40 large grocery bags and numerous small grocery bags of canned and boxed food products). In addition, we delivered numerous large boxes full of soap, shampoo, body wash, deodorant, toothpaste and toothbrushes; numerous large boxes and bags of clothes, winter wear (thermal gloves, sweaters, hats, thermal socks), bins of new pillows (8) and new twin bedding sets (8), and numerous smaller bags of bath products. Please keep your donations and prayers coming, especially given the cold weather. Casserole tins, recipes, and wish lists are in the cabinet in the freezer room next to the Narthex (church lobby).

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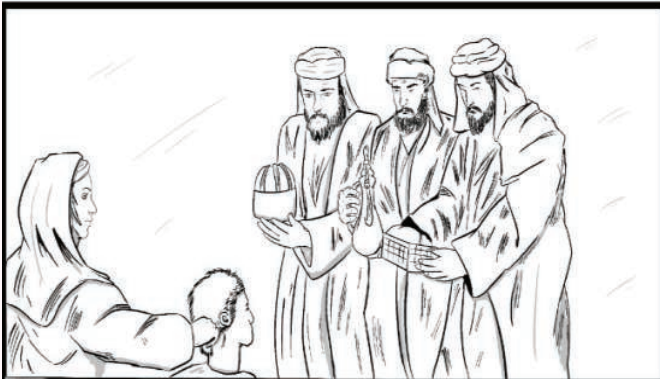
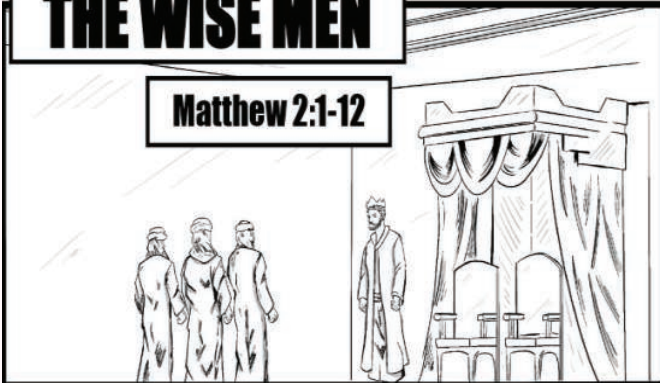

THE WISE MEN

Matthew 2:1-12



Dear Families,

Today is known as the Epiphany. What is an Epiphany? It is when we have a sudden insight. Liturgically, it is when Jesus is revealed to the world in the Gospel today, that the wisemen or magi visited Jesus.

In Matthew's Gospel, Herod, who the Holy Family fled from, asked the three wisemen to let him know where the baby Jesus was so he could pay "his respects to him." The wisemen left him and followed a star to Jesus. They were happy to see Him and genuflected in His presence just like we do when we are in church in Jesus' presence. They gave Him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. These gifts symbolized who Jesus was: king (gold) and priest (frankincense) as well as myrrh which was used in burials and foreshadowed what was in store for Jesus.

The wisemen sensing that Herod had something sinister in mind when they had met with him, went another way home so they would not run into Herod.

May we be like the Wise Men and be guided to our Lord. May we follow our light, Jesus. May we have courage and persistence to always turn away from evil like the magi did with Herod. May we always worship our Lord. May we always have a relationship with our Lord. May we be thankful for all that He has done and continues to do for us.
