Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

News from Fr. Reilly's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

As we begin the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday this week it would be good to begin to sketch some possible Lenten plans. Getting ready for Lent is as simple as stop, look and listen: Stop your activity for a few minutes; take a look at your life; listen to the Holy Spirit within you. When you do that, you will be able to tailor your resolutions to your own needs. This year as a parish, we will have a Lenten theme to help us spiritually prepare ourselves over these 40 days. Our Parish Lenten Theme: "May our hearts thirst for the Living God."

During this sacred time of Lent during the month of March, we will have many wonderful opportunities to spiritually prepare ourselves for Easter. Our Ash Wednesday schedule for Masses and distribution of ashes will be: 8:30 AM, 10:00 AM (school Mass), 7:00 PM and a 12:10pm prayer service.

This weekend we begin our 40 Hours devotions as a parish family. Immediately following the 11:30 AM Mass on Sunday, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until after our devotions at 7:00 PM. It will then be exposed after the 8:00 AM morning Mass and remain exposed until after our devotions at 7:00 PM on Monday and Tuesday. I have asked Rev. Randy Kraft, friend and neighbor of St. Agnes Parish, to come and lead us in these devotions each night. I pray that you can make some time to spend with the Lord over these next few days; and if you do and are able, may they truly be a blessing to you as we enter the Lenten season!

On March 17 to 19 at 7:00 PM, we as a parish family will have a St. Joseph Triduum where we will honor St. Joseph. Each night there will be Exposition, Benediction, Devotions and Prayers with guest homilists.

Our "40 days" of Lent is a round number with symbolic meaning. The Jews spent "40 years" in the desert on their way to the Promised Land. Jesus spent "40 days and 40 nights" fasting in the desert before beginning his ministry. In the early centuries of the Church, the fasting days leading up to Easter varied ~ in some places two days, in others a week. Gradually this grew longer and longer, and by the mid-fourth century, Lent began six weeks before Easter on the first Sunday of Lent.

However, fasting was always prohibited on Sunday, which meant that there were only 36 fasting days in the six-week period. To make the Lenten fast include 40 days, the Church added four days of fasting (Ash Wednesday and the three days following). Lent itself ends on the evening of Holy Thursday, thus beginning the Triduum. I do pray and hope that this sacred season of Lent will be one of great blessings for you and your family.

40 Hour Devotion

February 15, 16, 17, 2026

What exactly is Forty Hours Devotion?

Forty Hours Devotion is a special period of continuous prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, which is the real and true Presence of the Lord. This solemn Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament reminds us of the 40 hours that Christ's body rested in the tomb before His Resurrection.

Forty Hours Devotion begins with an opening Mass which concludes with Exposition. The Blessed Sacrament remains exposed on the altar in a monstrance for 40 hours, while people gather for quiet prayer in adoration of our Lord. Forty Hours concludes with Mass, benediction and final reposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

In many parishes, the forty hours are interrupted during the night and the devotion extends over three days. These days are similar to a parish retreat with a guest priest and evening prayer, but the focus is always on the Blessed Sacrament.

History: St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria introduced this devotion in 1527 in Milan; it was later spread by the Jesuits under St. Ignatius, and approved by many Popes. In 1853, St. John Neumann introduced 40 Hours Devotion in America when he was Bishop of Philadelphia.

The 2nd Vatican Council in 1964 stated that the Holy Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life" (Lumen Gentium, #11). Although Mass is the central act of worship for Catholics, the Council encouraged adoration of the Blessed Sacrament outside of the Mass.

Mark your calendars for Sunday February 15 through Tuesday, February 17. Forty Hours Devotion will begin at the end of the 11:30 AM Mass and continue each day. Evening prayer will be held at 7:00 PM on Sunday and Monday; closing Mass on Tuesday at 7:00 PM.

To the Homeless

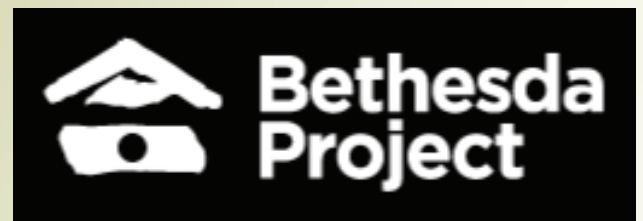
Bethesda Project

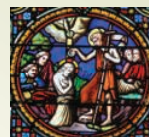

Please return clothing on hangers labeled with the child's name and ID code to the Narthex on or before March 15, 2026.

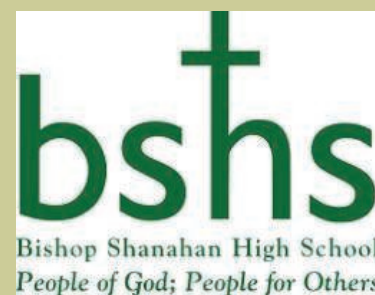
