Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

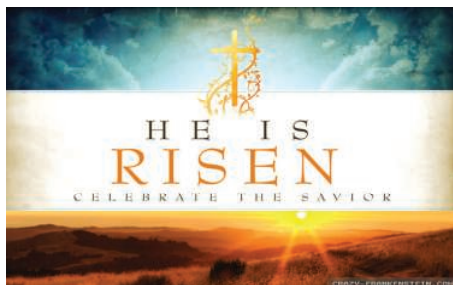

News from Fr. Reilly's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Saint Andrew of Crete, an eighth-century bishop and theologian, in reflecting upon Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, once wrote, "It is ourselves that we must spread under Christ's feet, not coats or lifeless branches or shoots of trees, matter which wastes away and delights the eye for only a few brief hours. But we have clothed ourselves with Christ's grace, with the whole Christ – for as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ – so let us spread ourselves like coats under his feet."

As we enter into this Holy Week, we need to take Andrew of Crete's advice and spread ourselves out before Christ; we need to join with other disciples and be there with Jesus on the path to Jerusalem, to gather in the Upper Room, and to learn the lessons of humility as our feet are washed and we learn to wash the feet of others. We need to sing in the garden after the Last Supper and be there with Peter as he denies the Messiah. We need to stand at the foot of the cross with Mary and John.

We need this week, which calls us to set aside our routines, to remove ourselves from all that is predictable in our lives and simply spread ourselves out before the Lord. We need to watch and wait together as we once again recall the events which gained for us the great and precious gift of our salvation.

Fr. Reilly's Liturgical Tidbit

Collect

The Introductory Rites always conclude with the prayer of the priest. The prayer was once called the "Collect, since it collects all the individual prayers of the assembly and summarizes them in the official prayer of the church which the presider prays. The prayer, as all official prayers, is always addressed to the Father through the Son and the Holy Spirit. What we do not always remember is that the important part of the prayer is the communal silence after the words "Let us pray." This is our time to pray together but in the silence of our hearts. Only after this silent time does the presider conclude by praying the Opening Prayer out loud. Our "Amen" voices our assent to the prayer and also concludes the Introductory Rites.

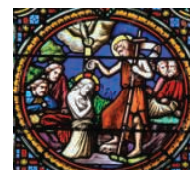

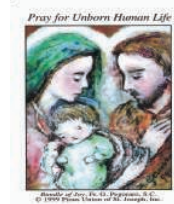

There is so much to digest in today's Gospel. Jesus prepares to be turned over for His crucifixion. Put yourself in Jesus' shoes. Think of how Jesus must have felt.

Pontius Pilate questions Jesus. The crowd is yelling, crucify Him. A guilty man, Barabbas, released. An innocent man, our Lord, condemned. The Blessed Mother standing powerless to help her Son.

The soldiers, took Jesus' clothes and put a crown of thorns on His head. They mocked Him. They spat on Him. They struck Him.

From noon onward, darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon when Jesus said, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Jesus then gave up His spirit. **At this part of Mass, we kneel and reflect about Jesus' sacrifice for us.**

Then we hear how the earth quaked, rocks split, tombs opened, and the bodies of many saints who had fallen asleep were raised. The centurion and the men with him who watching over Jesus feared greatly when they saw the earthquake and realized the truth, "**Truly, this was the Son of God!**"
