Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

News from Fr. Reilly's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Today, as we continue to revel in the glories of the Easter season, we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday. Today's readings reflect on the love Jesus has for us and his deep concern for each one of us individually. The focus is on Jesus, the shepherd and guardian of our souls, as Saint Peter describes him.

As your pastor, I am to follow the role of the Good Shepherd and exemplify that to all of you. This approach takes many forms, since I must deal with the spiritual and financial component of leading a parish in my role as a pastor. I am truly blessed to be here, since we are a thriving parish and have many opportunities to grow spiritually in our relationship with the Good Shepherd. However, we still have a few lost sheep out there who need to find their way back to the practice of the faith and join us at Mass on Sundays.

I would like to share with you the following information from our parish reports.

According to our statistics as of April 3, 2026:

Registered Families ~ 2,190

Registered Individuals (make up registered families) ~ 5,905

Registered Families using envelopes and e-giving ~ 515

~ therefore only 24% of registered families are participating/active but does not mean that they are coming to weekly Mass as determined by the envelope usage (some drop off envelopes/mail envelopes/use e-giving; while others only use Christmas/Easter)

~ the remaining 76% majority of our parish is dormant

The Archdiocesan wide October Count, asks us to count the attendance at every Mass during the month of October to calculate the average attendance at Sunday Mass.

This year our October Count average is 1383 total weekend Mass attendance.

2023 October Count ~ 1194 2024 October Count ~ 1247

We are registering new families to the parish on a weekly basis. As of today, we have registered 23 new families since January 1, 2026.

Sacraments are still stable:

Baptisms ~ 2023 there were 50

~ 2024 there were 61

~ 2025 there were 72

(2026 there have been 22 baptisms to date)

Marriages ~ 2023 there were 9

~ 2024 there were 8

~ 2025 there were 12

(2026 there have been 6 with 4 scheduled to the end of the year)

Funerals ~ 2023 there were 56

~ 2024 there were 45

~ 2025 there were 47

(2026 there have been 7 with 0 scheduled to the end of the year....
just wanted to make sure you were paying attention!)

So as you can see, we are going strong as a parish family. I do personally believe that we will continue to grow and flourish as a parish, if we come together, embrace one another and extend that personal invitation to someone to come back to Church. If you have any ideas on how to reach out to our lost brothers and sisters to invite them back to practice the faith, please feel free to contact me.

As we strive to follow the Good Shepherd, let us pray for the grace to imitate sheep in their recognition of the Shepherd's voice and in their absolute trust of his love and concern for us. And let us pray for members of Jesus' flock, and for those not yet of his flock, that all might faithfully follow him and inspire others to join the fold of the Good Shepherd.

Fr. Reilly's Liturgical Tidbit

Psalms

Question: What is the book of Psalms? How is the psalm chosen for Mass?

Answer: The book of Psalms is probably the most popular book of the Old Testament.

It is a songbook. David, whose ability on the lyre (the early forerunner of the guitar) got him a job with King Saul, wrote most of the psalms. Some were written during victory, some during personal tragedy. Other psalms were written by Asaph, the chief song leader in David's court. In our liturgy, the texts from many of our songs come from the Book of Psalms. Our deepest thoughts, our fullest emotions find their outlet in music. Sometimes when people can't seem to come out and say what is going on inside them, they create a song. This is what the psalmists did. Each created songs about God, God's people, or some deep emotion- and we are still singing them. In fact, as a people, we are re-discovering the psalms through the songs we are singing. Songs like "On Eagles' Wings," and "You Are Near," to give just examples, are either direct or poetic translations of the psalms. They are making the Psalter once more the "book of common prayer."

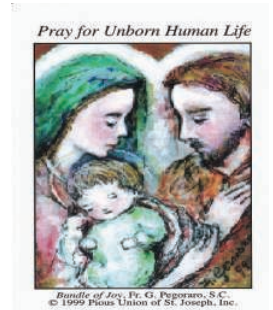


Adult Faith Formation

Today, the 4th Sunday of Easter, Jesus reminds us that He is our Good Shepherd. He calls us by name. He is our friend. He looks out for us.

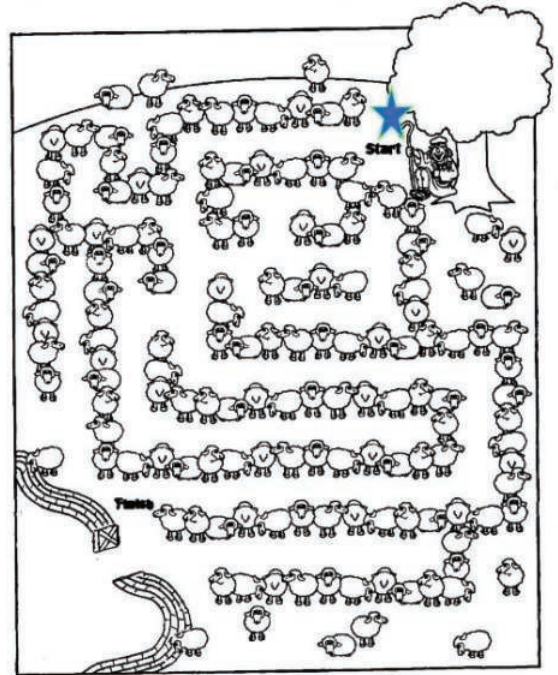
If we follow our Lord, we will be saved. He came so we might have eternal life.

Also known as CCD, starts the week of June 15. All children going into first grade and up are welcome! Click on the QR code to register!

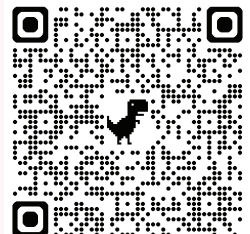
PREP is for rising 1 through 7 graders in public, non-Catholic private schools or children who are home-schooled. Please save the week of June 15 through June 19.
