Eligibility to be a Sponsor

For a person to act as a sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation, they must receive a letter from the parish to which he or she belongs, stating: he or she is at least sixteen years old, must have already received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist). He or she must be able to fulfill the responsibilities involved with being a sponsor. A sponsor who is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church.

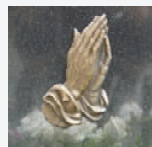

Volunteer as a Marshall for the National Eucharistic Procession in Philadelphia on July 5!

The Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul is looking for 40-50 volunteers who would like to serve as Procession Marshalls during the Eucharistic Procession from the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul to the National Shrine of St. John Neumann on Sunday, January 5, 2026.

Schedule for the Eucharistic Procession

- 11:00 AM - Solemn Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul
- 12:30 PM - Procession begins in front of the Cathedral, process 2 miles
- 1:30 PM - Arrival at the National Shrine of St. John Neumann with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament followed by a social

Marshall responsibilities include:

- ✓ *Walking the entirety of the 2-mile Procession route from the Cathedral Basilica to the Shrine of St. John Neumann*
- ✓ *Being alert for needs from pilgrims such as water, directions, assistance for medical attention, etc.*
- ✓ *Carrying a small backpack with water/essentials for needs of pilgrims*
- ✓ *Attending a short pre-Procession orientation at a designated time and place prior to the start of the Procession*
- ✓ *Any other needs as they arise before, during, and after the Procession*

Dear Families,

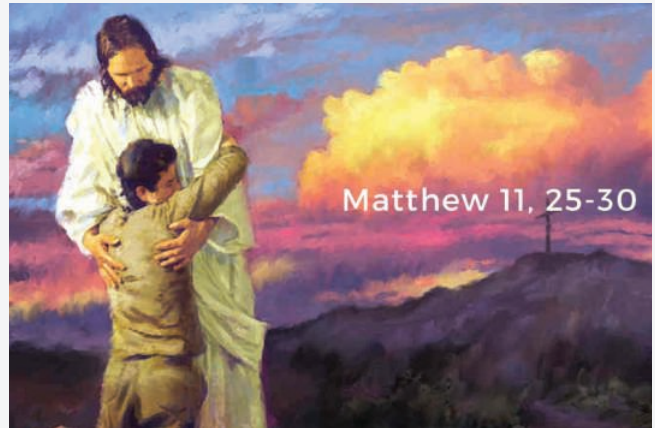
