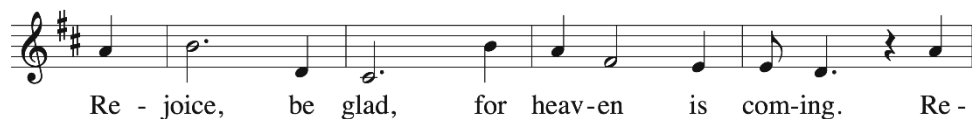
Spiritual Communion Prayer
