From the Pastor's Desk...



The month of May in the Catholic Church is also always the month of Mary, our Mother and our Queen. You can't get too much of a good thing when it comes to loving our Blessed Mother. Mary wants nothing better than to have us join her in heaven, because that is what is most pleasing to God. So, the more we turn to her, the more she will be able to help us. Here are 10 reasons to increase our love for the Mother of God.

1. Loving Mary is Pleasing to God. We cannot outdo God. No one has ever loved and honored Mary more than God has. God the Father chose her to be the Mother of his only Son. Mary is the spouse of the Holy Spirit, and Mother to God's only begotten Son.

2. *She is God's Perfect Instrument*. The well-known spiritual writer, Thomas Merton, once said, "As the most humble handmaid of the Lord who is 'full of grace,' Mary was the per-

fect instrument of God, because she was nothing else, but his instrument."

- 3. *It's a Way to Imitate Jesus*. Jesus follows the Fourth Commandment and honors his mother and earthly father, Joseph. We see this most clearly after they found him in the Temple at the age of 12. Though he has a higher calling, which is fulfilling the Will of His Heavenly Father, the adolescent Jesus shows us the importance of honoring his earthly parents.
- 4. *It's a Way to Imitate the Saints*. I don't believe there is a single saint that didn't love and honor Mary. Many of them were rarely without a rosary. The saints were wise enough to know that the one whom we refer to as the "Queen of all Saints" is the model for discipleship and sanctity.
- 5. *Mary has a Proven Track Record*. Jesus performed his first public miracle because his mother asked. He said it was not his time yet, but his mother asked for help. The Sacred Scriptures are clear: Mary had a profound influence upon the life of her Son.
- 6. *It's Scriptural to Include Mary.* The Blessed Mother was part of the Incarnation, birth, first miracle, passion and the death of our Lord Jesus, and with the apostles for the descent of the Holy Spirit, at Pentecost. It is also believed she was present for our Lord's Ascension. The first part of the Hail Mary is from Scripture and is centered on Jesus. Jesus and Mary go together.
- 7. *It's Historical*. During Old Testament times, it was the Queen, the king's mother in those days, who people went to with their requests. The best chance at getting a good answer from the king was to run it by his mother. That's the way it was done during King David's time and Jesus is descended from the House of David.
- 8. *God Continues to Give us his Mother*. A multitude of Church-approved Marian apparitions shows that God continues to send His mother to help us. Fatima, Lourdes, Guadalupe to name a few.
- 9. *Her Rosary is a Weapon*. Padre Pio and a host of saints called the rosary a weapon against evil and prayed it continually. Many documented miracles are attributed to praying the Rosary.
- 10. *Mary is Righteous*. The Bible attests to the power of her prayers. "The prayer of the righteous has great power in its effect" (James 5:16).


