## From the Pastor's Desk...



John Donne, a 17<sup>th</sup> century English poet, wrote a story about one man's search for God.

The man is told that God lives atop a high mountain at the end of the earth. After a long journey, the man arrives at the mountain and begins his climb. About the time that the man begins his ascent, God muses, "What can I do to show my people how much I love them?" God gets the idea to descend the mountain and live among his people as one of them.

And so, as the man is ascending one side of the mountain, God is descending the other side. However, they don't see each other because they are on opposite sides of the mountain. When the man reaches the mountaintop, he is heartbroken to find no one there. He thinks, "God doesn't live here after all." He even begins to think that God doesn't exist, saying, "If God doesn't live here, where does God live?"

Donne concludes, "God doesn't dwell on mountaintops, or in the midst of the desert, or at the ends of the earth. God dwells with men and women. God lives in the towns and cities of the world."

Of course, the reality is that God dwells everywhere. Yet, God especially desires to dwell within each one of us. The Eternal Word (His Son) became flesh and dwelt among us, lived with us, suffered for us, died for us, and rose for us for one reason. To show His incredible and unconditional love for us. The Transfiguration story was Jesus giving a few of his apostles a glimpse of their destiny. If our eyes and hearts are open, from time to time, Jesus will give us glimpses of our destiny – to be with Him eternally in heaven.

However, until that time comes, we have to descend the mountain and do our very best to strive to bring about a little more of that heaven here on earth. That is our mission. To strengthen us for this most important mission, Jesus has provided for us the most precious gift we could possibly ask for – the gift of Himself in the Eucharist. That is our weekly Transfiguration experience. That is how much Jesus loves us. He continues to give Himself to us at every Mass. Truly, we have not been abandoned.

Sadly, the numbers of people going to Mass have dropped greatly over the past few decades. Many claim they can commune with God on their own, and they don't need a religious community. This clearly was not what Jesus intended. Jesus greatly desires that we come together around our common altar to receive His most precious gift to us. Our world is hurting and I believe almost in direct proportion to the number of people who now practice nothing.

So, in this year of Eucharistic Revival we must pray for our brothers and sisters who have wandered far from the fold. Holy Spirit we need them back. May they come to realize just what they are missing and how much we need them. The Body of Christ on earth is calling for all our lost brothers and sisters.

### Missionaries of St. Francis De Sales

On August 19-20, 2023, we will have the Annual Mission Appeal in our parish. This year the holy mass and homily will be celebrated by a priest from the Missionaries of St. Francis, otherwise known as the Fransalians. Although their congregation was founded in Annecy, France in 1837, as missionaries, their major presence is now in Asia and Africa along with new missions in South America.

They are now globally present in 29 countries with 12 provinces, one region and four delegations with total membership of more than 1500 confreres. Their main missionary charism is the pioneering evangelization in the non-evangelized countries and the education of the less privileged youth through children's homes and orphanages. More than 3500 economically poor, semi orphan or orphan children are cared for and educated in their 93 children's homes both in India and Africa. The Fransalians are also active in the Philippines, Ecuador, Indonesia and Brazil where they promote and train missionary vocations to prepare individuals for both pioneering evangelization and the renewal of Christian life in different countries and are actively engaged in the empowerment of women and the marginalized.

Let us welcome our missionary Fr. Abraham Vettuvellil MSFS.

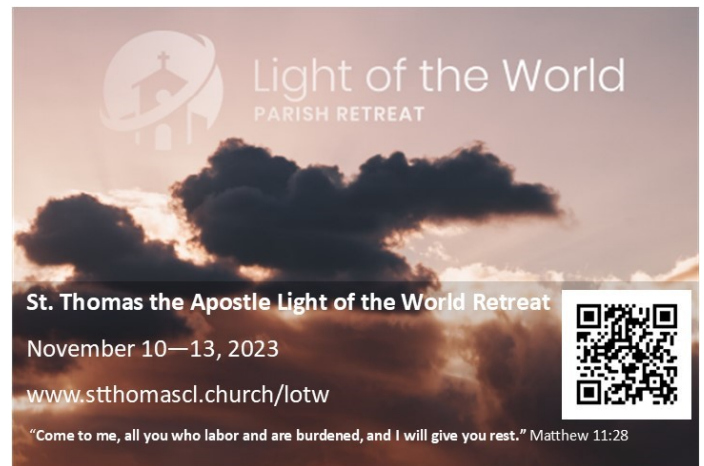

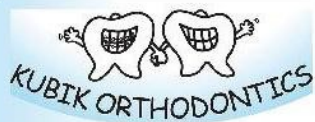

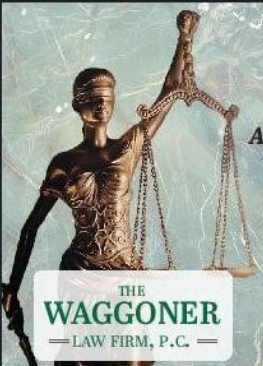
