From the Pastor's Desk...



As we prepare for the Centennial Celebration of St. Thomas the Apostle School in 2027, we renew our commitment to making the school a place where young people can come to know, love and serve the Lord in an academic environment of excellence and integrity. As previously announced, we have engaged the services of Avanti Advisors from Philadelphia, PA to work with our school and parish leadership to strengthen communication, advise us on enrollment management strategies, and assist us with thinking about the needs of fundraising, development, and alumni relations. Our consultant for this project will be the owner and founder of the company, Mr. Christopher Mominey, whose resume I included in last weekend's bulletin column.

When it comes to St. Thomas the Apostle School, we have good reason to take pride in our past. We must also come together as a community that has faith in our future. I am fully aware that these are challenging times for our Catholic institutions. These challenges have resulted in several people walking away from the very institutions that have contributed to the backbone and moral fiber of our country.

The following quote comes from a Conference at the University of Notre Dame in 2006: "Will it be said of our generation that we presided over the demise of the most effective and important resource for evangelization in the history of the Church in the United States? Will it be said of our generation that we lacked the resolve to preserve national treasures built upon the sacrifice of untold millions? Will it be said of our generation that we abandoned these powerful instruments of justice that provide educational opportunity and hope for families otherwise trapped in poverty? Surely not. Instead, when the story of Catholic schools is written, historians will look back on our age and marvel that against great odds, we change the ending."

The above quote serves as very inspirational for me and hope it is also for you. In St. Thomas the Apostle School we have a tremendous gift and blessing. We need to preserve this gift. As your pastor that is very important to me, but I will need the help of our faith community (and other parishes) to make sure our school grows and thrives as we prepare to begin the second century for St. Thomas the Apostle School.

We are hosting a Community Convocation for all parents and parishioners this Wednesday, August 23rd, beginning at 7:00 pm in the Community Room at our Oak Street campus. The purpose for this gathering is threefold:

To introduce Chris Mominey to our community and welcome him as he begins this year-long project with us.

To hear Chris' vision for Catholic education here at St. Thomas the Apostle.

To communicate the overall project goals for the coming year.

There will be some time for questions and answers based on Chris' presentation, but the convocation will end promptly at 8:00 pm. Missionaries of St. Francis De Sales

On August 19-20, 2023, we will have the Annual Mission Appeal in our parish. This year the holy mass and homily will be celebrated by a priest from the Missionaries of St. Francis, otherwise known as the Fransalians. Although their congregation was founded in Annecy, France in 1837, as missionaries, their major presence is now in Asia and Africa along with new missions in South America.

They are now globally present in 29 countries with 12 provinces, one region and four delegations with total membership of more than 1500 confreres. Their main missionary charism is the pioneering evangelization in the non-evangelized countries and the education of the less privileged youth through children's homes and orphanages. More than 3500 economically poor, semi orphan or orphan children are cared for and educated in their 93 children's homes both in India and Africa. The Fransalians are also active in the Philippines, Ecuador, Indonesia and Brazil where they promote and train missionary vocations to prepare individuals for both pioneering evangelization and the renewal of Christian life in different countries and are actively engaged in the empowerment of women and the marginalized.

Let us welcome our missionary Fr. Abraham Vettuvelil MSFS.


