

From the Pastor's Desk...



I recently came across this list and I thought it would be worth sharing. It is 15 common Catholic Church "Facts" that Protestants constantly get wrong:

Catholics don't read their Bibles. Actually, since the Second Vatican Council in the 1960's many practicing Catholics have been reading their Bibles more, and there are many more Catholic Bible studies available, like "The Bible Timeline" that is being offered here at St. Thomas.

Catholics don't pray to Jesus. There has been an increased emphasis in the Catholic Church on the importance of having a relationship with Jesus through our prayer lives. It has always been part of our teaching, but thankfully is now being empha-

sized more.

Catholics believe that their Pope is never wrong. We believe the Pope is a fallible human being but can declare an infallible doctrine supported by Scripture and Sacred Tradition. This has only happened twice – The doctrines of the Assumption and the Immaculate Conception.

Catholics aren't Christians. A good understanding of Church History will show that Catholics are actually the first Christians, since Protestantism came many centuries later.

Catholics worship Mary, the Saints and Statues. Catholics worship our Triune God (Father, Son & Holy Spirit). We venerate (honor) Mary and the Saints. Statues (art) are objects of veneration that may represent our God, Mary and the Saints, but we must never worship these objects.

Catholics believe that people are saved by good works. We do not believe that we can merit our way into heaven simply through our good works alone. We believe that salvation comes from (faith) in God's gift of grace and our participation (good works) in that grace.

Catholics believe they can sin all they want and then go to Confession. We do believe in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, but we also believe it is the sin of Presumption to play games with this sacrament and to insincerely take God's mercy, love and forgiveness for granted.

The Catholic Church discriminates against non-Catholics by not letting them receive Communion. The Catholic Church is the only Church that believes in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and protects this belief by reserving the reception to Practicing Catholics.

The Catholic Church added books to the Bible. No, actually the Protestant Church removed some books from the Bible during the Reformation, which had been part of the Bible for over a millennium.

Catholics believe that only they go to heaven. No, we believe that final judgment belongs to Christ, that the Catholic Church is the fullest expression of the faith to assist our life journey.

We have a wonderful faith that is often misunderstood. It is important for us to know what we believe, so we can more fully celebrate it and defend it.
