From the Pastor's Desk...



This coming Wednesday, April 9, is Be-Reconciled Day in the Rockford Diocese, which means parishes throughout the diocese will be offering an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation throughout the day. The Sacrament of Reconciliation, also known as Confession, is a crucial component of the Catholic faith. It provides individuals with the opportunity to seek forgiveness for their sins and reconcile with God. Through this sacrament, believers can experience spiritual healing, renewal, and a deeper connection with their faith.

What are the necessary steps required for the Sacrament of Reconciliation?

- 1. Examination of Conscience Before going to receive the sacrament, it is important to prepare by examining your conscience. This involves reflecting on your thoughts, words, and actions since your last confession. The Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, and the Gospel teachings of Jesus are all excellent guides to assist your personal reflection on your relationship with God and others. As we seek God's forgiveness it is important to ask are we loving, compassionate and merciful?
- 2. Confession of Sins Upon greeting the priest, mention when your last confession was (if you can remember). If it's been a long time don't be intimidated. The priest should welcome you back to the sacrament. Then simply acknowledge your faults and seek the healing that the sacrament offers. Although this is not time for an extended counseling session, it is fine to receive some guidance for your life.
- 3. Act of Contrition It is then appropriate to express your sorrow for your sins through a heartfelt prayer, demonstrating your desire for forgiveness and amendment of life. There are many standard Act of Contrition prayers that most people use, or you may put one in your own words. The important thing is to express sorrow for your sins and your desire to receive the mercy, love and forgiveness of God and the Church in the sacrament.
- 4. *Penance* The priest will give you a Penance, which is usually a Prayer, a Healing Action, or a Charitable Action. Accept and fulfill the Penance given by the priest as way to make amends and grow in spiritual discipline and spiritual health.
- 5. *Absolution* Receive the priest's Prayer of Absolution, where God's forgiveness is pronounced, and the Grace of the Sacrament is bestowed on the Penitent.

It is my hope and prayer that many will be able to take advantage of Be-Reconciled Day, and experience a wonderful sense of healing, renewal, and closeness to God.




