From the Pastor's Desk...



Fr. Tommy Lane offered a homily very similar to this 20 years ago in Maryland. I believe it bears repeating today: Who would have thought that the crowd which welcomed Jesus with such enthusiasm during his entry into Jerusalem would turn against him so quickly within days and demand his crucifixion and the release of Barabbas who had been condemned for murder? These are the scenes that play out in our Palm Sunday Liturgy. We begin the service with praises for Jesus, "Hosanna, hosanna, to the King!" However, by the time we get to the Passion reading the focus has shifted to calling for the crucifixion of our Lord.

The crowd was fickle. Their welcome and shouts for Jesus were superficial. Their support for him was only skin deep. It was easy to be part of a crowd that welcomed Jesus, and it was easy to be part of a crowd that condemned him to death. It is easy to be part of a crowd. But in the account of the Passion, the crowd was not there for Jesus when he needed them the most. The crowd did not go to the cross. The crowd abandoned Jesus. Only a few women and John went to the cross. So much for the crowd!

During the Last Supper, Peter said he would be willing to go to prison with Jesus, even to death with him (Luke 22:33). Yet a few hours later that same evening he denied Jesus (Luke 22:56-62). How quickly he changed. How quickly he turned when the pressure was on him. He could make fine promises during the Last Supper but when things got rough he decided to save his skin.

How would we react if placed in a similar situation? Would we cave into the pressure like Peter, or do we stand by Jesus like the women and John and go right to the cross? Peter heard the cock crow crowing after he denied Jesus (Luke 22:60) but our world is so addicted to sin that maybe we don't even hear our consciences crowing any more when we sin.

The Passion of Jesus should move us because it is we who have inflicted this suffering on Jesus. It was not just the Jewish leaders and the cruel Roman soldiers who brought this suffering on Jesus. No, it was our sins, as well that inflicted this suffering. There is no past, present or future for Jesus. He is outside of time. Remember the Jubilee 2000 motto, "Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever" (Hebrews 13:8) and when we sin, we crucify Jesus. We nail him again. The account of the Passion of Jesus should move us to flee sin and leave it behind. That is why the Sacrament of Reconciliation is so stressed during this time of year. There are still opportunities this Holy Week to partake in this important sacrament of our Lord's mercy, love and forgiveness.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Good Friday, April 18, is a day of fast and abstinence.

ABSTINENCE: All persons who have completed their <u>fourteenth</u> year are bound by the Law of Abstinence, which means no meat may be eaten.

FAST: All adults are bound by the law of fast from their <u>eighteenth</u> year up to the beginning of their <u>sixtieth</u> year (only one full meal, and two other light meals). While not a law, the Church does encourage us to continue the fast and abstinence through Holy Saturday if we possibly can.

EXCEPTIONS: Women who are pregnant and persons who are sick are not bound by the law of fast.

At our 6:00 pm Holy Thursday Mass, we will be taking a collection for the Crystal Lake Food Pantry. It is customary to take a collection on Holy Thursday.


Holy Hearts Adoration Chapel
