From the Pastor's Desk...



A parishioner recently shared this story with me, and I thought I would share it with you this Easter Sunday. It was Easter morning. My Lenten preparations were dutifully finished. One would expect I felt renewed, happy, and grateful as the springtime sunlight embraced me with warmth through the windowpanes.

Instead, this morning I entered the tomb of my bedroom with dragons crowding my mind. The weight of responsibility to provide for my young family was bearing down on me. The year had not gone well. I lost my job. My new one didn't pay well and was demoralizing. Every tiny expense was a burdensome decision.

My 5-year-old son walked in cheerfully holding out a package, recklessly covered in expensive paper I was saving for an anniversary gift to my wife. He clasped his hands against his mouth, bouncing on his toes as he handed it to me with excited anticipation.

Dragging myself half away from my self-pity, I removed the paper to find a small plastic Easter egg. I opened it. It was empty.

I began to lecture him on the value of money and the importance of not wasting expensive wrapping paper on an empty plastic egg. With a startled, sad face he looked up and said, "But daddy, I put a kiss in it."

Immediately I was crushed by my selfish, prideful sin. I hugged him, thanked him, and said I was sorry. Naturally, he smiled and said, "That's OK daddy. I love you."

Easter is like that. We find Christ's face in the most unassuming, unexpected places if we prepare for it and watch for it.

I'm an older man now. The small plastic egg is nestled safely in my sock drawer. Over 55 years later, I still occasionally take it out, remember, repent, renew its lessons. Like the empty tomb on Easter morning, God's unseen blessings are all around us. And are often in things as gentle and forgiving as a young child's eyes.

May the story of the empty tomb (and the empty egg) fill you with great joy and hope throughout this Easter season. Today we celebrate the fact that Christ did what he said he would do. He conquered sin and death, which opened up our path to salvation. For that we can all proclaim, "Alleluia!"






