

From the Pastor's Desk...



Divine Mercy Sunday is now a Universal Church Feast observed annually on the First Sunday after Easter. In her *Diary*, St. Faustina Kowalska recorded 14 revelations from our Lord requesting this feast. The most complete, concise description is found in entry 699:

"I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. ... The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." We also are encouraged to venerate (make some gesture of deep religious respect toward) the Divine Mercy Im-

age and perform acts of mercy through deed, word, and/or prayer.

Next weekend every parish in our diocese will be asked to participate in the 2025 Diocesan Appeal. This campaign has enormous impact on the ministries and programs that are offered at our parish and throughout the diocese. The theme of the appeal this year is "That All May Be One." This theme reflects the motto of Bishop Arthur J. O'Neill, the influential shepherd who began our appeal fifty years ago. Bishop O'Neill is also the bishop who ordained me in 1992, so I was honored when the diocese requested my participation in this year's video to announce the 2025 appeal.

The Church is reminded by the Eucharist she celebrates and the Gospel she proclaims, that her mission is unity and that her service is to all people. Diocesan ministries, programs, and services funded by the appeal would not be possible without the generosity of the people of this diocese. Catholic Charities, Catholic Schools, Religious Education and Youth Ministry, Lay Ministry Adult Faith Formation, Seminarian and Deacon Formation, Marriage Preparation, Administrative Tasks (health insurance, payroll, etc.), and much more are made possible by your support of this annual appeal.

I invite you to take to heart the theme of this year's appeal, "That All May Be One." Please prayerfully consider making a gift to the 2025 Diocesan Annual Appeal. Every gift makes a profound difference in the life of our parish and our diocese. Every gift — large or small — is greatly appreciated.

Thank you so much for your kind consideration of this important effort. May all of us continue to grow in our love of Christ!


Women's Club Luncheon


Diocesan Annual Appeal May 3-4, 2025 "That All May Be One"

Our Annual Diocesan Appeal for 2025 will be held on May 3-4, 2025. **Our Parish Target Goal Amount is \$207,957.00** (this is a decrease from our 2024 target amount of \$222,140.00). Please know how deeply grateful we are to you for your continued support of this Annual Appeal. Through your generosity and prayers, we have continually made our target goal amounts. Thank you.

The theme for this year's Appeal is "That All May Be One." Bishop Arthur O'Neill began the Diocesan Appeal in 1975. Bishop O'Neill's intent was for us to understand and recognize more deeply the importance of what it means to be a Diocesan Church, and for all of us to be more connected to its life and mission. In the Rockford Diocese:

- We have 13 seminarians studying for the priesthood;
- 108 active priests;
- 13 men studying to be ordained to the Permanent Diaconate;
- 14,730 children participating in religious education programs;
- 412,867 Catholics living in the Diocese;
- 7,864 students in our Catholic schools;

Once our target amount has been reached, our parish will receive the overpayment amount. Thank you for your support and prayers so "that all may be one."

Day 8 (Easter Friday) is "the souls who are detained in purgatory;"

Day 9 (Easter Saturday) is "the souls who have become lukewarm."




