

From the Pastor's Desk...



The Jubilee Year of Hope enters the dog days of summer during August. The Sunday readings present images and experiences that reveal where hope can be found and how it can be cultivated to give "inward direction and purpose to the life of believers" (Pope Francis, *Spes Non Confundit, No. 18*). Our readings today confront us with a challenge to life's purpose and point us toward a graced response.

Ecclesiastes (also known as Qoheleth) states the perennial problem: Life seems absurd! We spend years learning "wisdom and knowledge and skill." We labor for most of our lives (all our days "under the sun"). But what good ("profit") does that do us if, in the end, we die and must leave it all behind? That experience and others

prompts the frustrated author to groan that life is a "vanity of vanities". Clearly, the passage states a human struggle for meaning where in the face of much that seems futile.

Today's Gospel depicts this reality sharply. Jesus speaks of a rich man with a bountiful harvest. He is a model of economic, and therefore social success. He has sufficient treasure to "rest, eat, drink, and be merry". He has all the pleasures that seem to make life meaningful. Yet his accumulated wealth cannot stave off the demands of mortality. When his life abruptly and unexpectedly ends ("this night"), all that he has built for himself is left to someone else. So, one might be tempted to ask, "What is the point?"

The Gospel reaffirms hope by shifting our focus to a very different notion of riches. The Gospel shifts our focus to "what matters to God," who is not subject to mortality. Treasure for our Lord and His Gospel message derives not from labor or wealth, but from belief. St. Paul reminds the Colossians of their baptism – in which they "have died" and "were raised with Christ." We too are called to reflect upon the meaning of our own baptism into the life of Jesus Christ. Transformed by grace, we are to seek hope not in empty promises of passing worldly success ("what is on earth") but from "above" – where new life "will appear with Christ in glory."

The reality of death calls into question the meaning of life. It also reminds us of the great reason for our faith in God who spoke all life into being. The grace of our baptism directs us to find hope in the One who is seated at the Father's right hand. The grace of our baptism redirects our attention away from earthly and passing treasure (vain pursuits) to a greater treasure that is envisioned above (the true fulfillment of our hopes and dreams).


