

## From the Pastor's Desk...



One of our parishioners, T.K. O'Hagan, shared the following story with me and I would like to share it with you today. "In the days before computers and cell phones ruled the Earth, families depended on refrigerator doors to organize and mark our achievements. Magnets strained to hold our children's crayon drawings, report cards, awards, etc. from Pre-K to Grad School.

I like to imagine our Heavenly Father having a refrigerator. In His eyes, the greatest accomplishments of humanity, from Aquinas to Einstein, are like crayon drawings of His children on His fridge. He must love them in the same way I loved my children's 1<sup>st</sup> drawings, printed words, and handmade birthday cards.

When I feel self-important or the devil sneaks back into my soul with his favorite vice (pride), it helps me to think of myself this way in God's eyes. He loves me. He loves every single time I try to please Him. I imagine the door of God's fridge reflects how He cherishes my childlike efforts to know and imitate Him.

Isn't it delightful to have a heavenly Father who loves each and every one of His children this much! I long for the day He will hug me and delight in showing me the door to His Heavenly fridge and the crayon drawings of my life hanging there."

In our Gospel today we hear about the narrow gate which leads to eternal life. The warnings might tend to frighten us, but Jesus doesn't want to scare us. He wants to save us. Jesus wants to help us enter the narrow gate by our acts of love and our obedience to His commands. The best news is that Jesus is the Gate! Yes, He is the door that leads to our eternal life. So, basically Jesus is saying keep your eyes fixed on Him and He will guide our way and lead us on that narrow path. He wants to save us. He will help us!






