

From the Pastor's Desk...



The Catholic Church in the United States traditionally celebrates Respect Life Sunday on the first Sunday of October. As Catholics, we believe that every human person is made in the image and likeness of God. Every human life is therefore sacred and inviolable and should be protected and cherished from conception until natural death. Practices such as abortion, assisted suicide, euthanasia, and capital punishment violate the dignity of the human person and must be rejected.

The Church's consistent life ethic sharply contrasts with the incoherent proclamation of human rights that fails to protect life when it is most vulnerable. Human rights without the right to life is an exercise in self-deception. The Church's Pro-Life

message is a great service to all society. The culture of death flows out of the extreme individualism of our age. The Church's antidote is community and solidarity, which are key elements of our Catholic Social teaching, which Pope Leo XIV has often referred to.

The Pro-Life movement needs to be the merciful face of God to women facing a difficult pregnancy. Being judgmental or condemnatory is not part of the Gospel of Life. The Pro-Life Movement has to be about saving Mothers. We need to focus on the women to try to understand what they are suffering. We also need to pray for men to embrace their responsibility not to force women into these difficult situations. And most certainly we need to pray for the innocent life in the womb, that we do all we can to respect, nurture and support the right to be born into this world.

Although laws have changed in many states making it more difficult to get abortions, the number of abortions is still rising. This is because many hearts have not changed. So, our prayers and Christian witness of love, mercy and respect for all life is needed now more than ever. Our prayers and witness have changed hearts! I think of Dr. Bernard Nathanson, once one of the most prominent leaders in Pro-Abortion movement until he finally heard that child's voice pointing out for him the inconvenient truth and grave error in his ways. That conversion led to his involvement in a powerful film – The Silent Scream – which also helped change more hearts. He spent the rest of his life spreading the Gospel of Life!

God's grace turned Saul of Tarsus, the implacable persecutor of the Church, into the Apostle of the Gentiles. That same grace transformed Bernard Nathanson, a leading voice in Pro-Abortion, into an apostle of the Gospel of Life. Many other hearts have changed over the years. Many more are waiting to be changed, but they need our prayer and Chistian witness. This Sunday afternoon's Life Chain on Route 14 might be a good start.


