From the Pastor's Desk...



As we come to the end of *National Vocation Awareness Week*, I thought it would be a good time to devote my column to Vocations. Although I did not realize it at the time, my own vocation was being fostered at a very young age. It started with my parents who provided a great example of living their faith. Going to Mass and being involved in parish life were simply a way of life for them, and therefore it also became a way of life for me. My vocation was then strengthened by Catholic Schooling in both Elementary School and High School. There were a number of the priests, religious sisters, and lay teachers who passed on their love of the Catholic Faith and strengthened my Faith. I am most grateful for my parents, many of their friends, and

some fine teachers for instilling a sense of God's love within me.

When I was a senior in High School I was asked by a parish priest (and teacher) if I had ever considered the priesthood. I shared that I honestly had never really considered myself living that vocation. The thought quite frankly scared me, mostly because I really did not deem myself to be worthy. Also, as a teenager I believed that a celibate life would simply be too hard to embrace. So, I went off to College and pursued a degree in Business. Yet, his invitation to consider the priesthood stayed with me. In College I found the Newman Center an important place to stay close to my Catholic Faith. I am extremely grateful for the Newman Canter and the fine priests and people that I met there.

After College, I worked in Retail Management for five years. The invitation to consider the priesthood was always in the back of my mind and heart. By the time I was 27 years old, I was ready to make a leap of faith. The Rockford Diocese supported my desire and helped me apply to Mundelein Seminary. I spent five years there and was ordained in 1992. My first assignment was here at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish (1992-1995). I was reassigned here as Pastor a little over 4 years ago.

It is a life that is full of many challenges, but also so much grace, and so much joy. I truly am grateful that I was offered that invitation so many years ago. Even though I did not immediately accept it, the invitation did not go away, and it did change my life for the better. I now live with 3 other fine priests, Fathers Downing, Fitzpatrick and Tunarosa. They have their own unique stories of "being called." I am very grateful for their vocation!

While here as a Seminarian, Fr. Ian Ordonez established a wonderful Vocation Wall over by the Sacristy Door. Please stop by and help yourself to a Seminarian Post Card. I invite you to place it on your fridge at home and to pray for our current seminarians and pray for more to embrace the call in the future.

On this feast, we remember more than a building. We celebrate the resiliency of our faith.
