From the Pastor's Desk...



Our Advent journey continues. We see two different images of the Coming Reign of God. Both are true and both can speak to us. Isaiah speaks of a time when the “Chosen One” of God will come and issue peace and mutual cooperation. His Coming (“advent”) will be marked by the gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, knowledge, understanding, counsel, piety, fortitude (courage), and fear of the Lord (awe). The “Chosen One” will come in judgment, not based on appearances, but with justice and peace. A sign of justice and peace are given in the images of new life sprouting from barren branches; and animals that are normally enemies of each other, now eating together. It will be a life totally different from that experienced presently.

The Gospel gives another image of the Coming Reign of God. It speaks of those who have not reformed their lives. They will face fire, wrath, and an ax. John the Baptist is a voice crying out in the wilderness. His voice is a voice of warning. He calls the people to repentance, in Greek, *METANOIA*. Metanoia means a change of direction, a change of heart and mind. It requires people to change their lives and open their hearts to the One Who is Coming.

These two images of the Advent or Coming of the Lord Jesus seems to contradict each other. Yet, if we look closer, they are linked together. John the Baptist is preparing others for the Coming. He wants people to be ready when the Coming One arrives. The way they do this is by reviewing their lives and seeing what is out of line with the vision presented by Isaiah. John calls for metanoia, particularly for those who are not living lives marked by the gifts of the Holy Spirit mentioned above.

What is the message for us? Simply put, and borrowing the motto of the American Coast Guard, “Semper Paratus – Always Prepared – Always Ready.” The members of the Coast Guard know that the Latin phrase is more than a state of mind or a catchy motto. It takes discipline, changing their way of life, exercising and training, and practice. It means living a style of life that reflects that they are ready for whatever might happen. For us who are waiting for the Second Coming of the Lord Jesus, it also means discipline. We cannot do it alone. We need the help of the Holy Spirit and the gifts that only the Spirit can provide. Let us pray for those gifts to guide us in this season of Advent.







Durante el Adviento, Dios nos brinda la oportunidad de trabajar y movernos, de no quedarnos en un solo sitio. Como ejemplo, tenemos a Juan Bautista, personaje importante de este tiempo. Él trabajó incansablemente anunciando cómo preparar el camino del Señor, cómo sería su venida. El profeta Isaías se refería a Juan de esta forma: *"Una voz grita en el desierto: preparen un camino al Señor, hagan sus senderos rectos"* (Juan 3:3). Hacer los senderos rectos, es decir, implica una conversión desde el fondo del corazón; un cambio radical a través de un proceso suave pero firme para llegar a Dios.

"La Iglesia de este tiempo es igual a un campo sembrado que tiene grano y paja mezclados, es decir, juntos buenos y malos. Después del juicio, en cambio, tendrá solamente buenos, sin malo alguno... De ahí vendrá el juzgar a vivos y muertos, y como dice el Evangelio: Él tiene el biello en su mano para separar el trigo de la paja. Guardará el trigo en su granero y quemará la paja en un fuego que no se extingue" (San Agustín, 354–430. Sermón 223). Preparados o no, este Adviento es el tiempo de aprender que los tiempos de Dios son momentos de gracia. Paja y trigo crecen en nosotros, y es tiempo de po-

nerse a trabajar en la conversión para ir al encuentro del Señor. No olvidemos que Dios espera de nosotros lo mejor y nos da la libertad de seguirlo o dejarlo. ¿Qué escoges? El tiempo de Adviento es para revisar nuestra conciencia: cómo pensamos, creemos y actuamos. ©LPi






