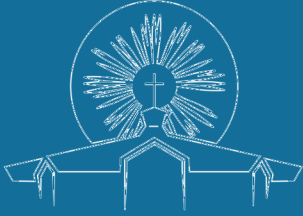

## From the Pastor's Desk...



This Sunday, on the Feast of Divine Mercy, we will offer a special Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament, beginning at 3:00 pm. The Eucharistic Holy Hour will include a recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, an opportunity to attend the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and an opportunity to venerate the Divine Mercy image. We sincerely hope that a great many of you will be able to attend this special afternoon service.

In February 1931, in Poland, Faustina Kowalska had visions of Jesus who tasked her with spreading a devotion to His Divine Mercy. Kowalska reported a number of apparitions which she described in her 1934-1938 diary, later published as the book

*Diary: Divine Mercy in My Soul*. The two main themes of the devotion are to trust in Christ's endless goodness, and to show mercy to others acting as a conduit for God's love towards them.

The primary focus of the Divine Mercy devotion is the merciful love of God and the desire to let that love and mercy flow through one's own heart towards those in need of it. As he dedicated the Shrine of Divine Mercy, St. Pope John Paul II referred to this when he said: "Apart from the mercy of God there is no other source of hope for humankind." There are seven main forms of this devotion:

1. The Divine Mercy image with the specific inscription *Jesus, I trust in You*.
2. The commemoration of the Feast of the Divine Mercy Sunday.
3. The recitation of the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy.
4. The recitation of the Divine Mercy Novena.
5. The designation of the Hour of Mercy at 3:00 pm.
6. Spreading mercy by word, deed, and/or prayer.
7. The spreading of works of mercy to the whole humanity, in preparation for the return of Jesus Christ to Earth. Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God.

The Corporal Works of Mercy are:

1. Feeding the Hungry
2. Giving Drink to the Thirsty
3. Sheltering the Homeless
4. Visiting the Sick
5. Visiting Prisoners
6. Burying the Dead
7. Giving Alms to the Poor

The Spiritual Works of Mercy are:

1. Counseling the Doubtful
2. Instructing the Ignorant
3. Admonishing the Sinner
4. Comforting the Sorrowful
5. Forgiving Injuries
6. Bearing Wrongs Patiently
7. Praying for the Living & the Dead

I am sure that we have all been involved in some of the above works of mercy. The lists are helpful to consider on this day, as we strive to be more intentional about these works.

**Fortitude**

“When you go out to war against your enemies and you see horses and chariots and an army greater than your own, you shall not be afraid of them,” we read in Deuteronomy 20:1. “For the Lord, your God...will be with you.”

The virtue of fortitude actually requires, first and foremost, the feeling of fear. In order to grow in fortitude, one must face a thing which frightens him; in that way, it is distinct from patience and perseverance. Christ shows perfect fortitude as he endures his Passion and death, of which he was indeed afraid; it is likewise shown by martyrs. But fortitude doesn’t require a cinematic battle. Fortitude can be shown by someone who is afraid of losing his job or of being in bodily danger simply for adhering to the laws of God. What is important is that the courage shown is in pursuit of the good, not just bearing with an attack. ©LPi



**Within Thy Wounds**

The prayer I love best in the world is the Anima Christi. This private, devotional litany of supplication, begins with the phrase “anima Christi, sanctifica me” (“soul of Christ, sanctify me”) and continues on to appeal individually to each aspect of Our Lord’s crucified flesh: “Body of Christ, save me; blood of Christ, inebriate me; water from Christ’s side, wash me; passion of Christ, strengthen me; Oh good Jesus, hear me.”

Then comes my favorite part: “within thy wounds hide me.”

The Anima Christi is a prayer traditionally said after receiving Holy Communion. The ancient Celts spoke of liminal places, where the veil separating this world from the next is particularly thin, and I believe the moments immediately following the reception of Holy Communion, when the Host is dissolving on my tongue, create a liminal place. When I am in that place, I am as intimately connected to God as I can be while my heart is still beating.

And when I am there, holding God within me, what are the words that I speak? It’s overwhelming to think about. What could possibly be right to say?

There is no right or wrong answer, I suppose. But the best words I can think of are these: “Within thy wounds, Lord, hide me.”

There is a reason Christ showed his wounds as he said the words, “Peace be with you.” It was not just a means of identifying himself — it was a catechism lesson. Here, he was saying. Here is the peace you will not find anywhere else. ©LPi

El misterio del Reino de Dios es comunicado por el evangelizador. Ese gran misterio es el que Jesús, en su vida terrena, trató de enseñar a sus discípulos, y ya resucitado, dio continuación a ese misterio. nos recuerda que ninguna persona en el mundo queda excluida de aportar su granito de arena por la paz y de demostrar la misericordia que existe en su corazón, para compartirla con su familia y con la sociedad. La valentía de anunciar la paz nunca termina. Pidamos, pues, con fe, este regalo para el mundo. ©LPi

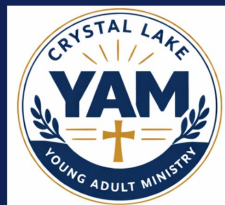

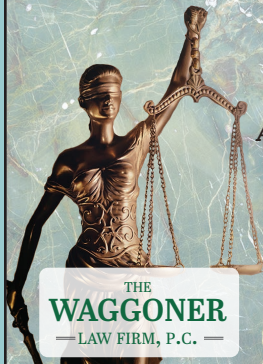
