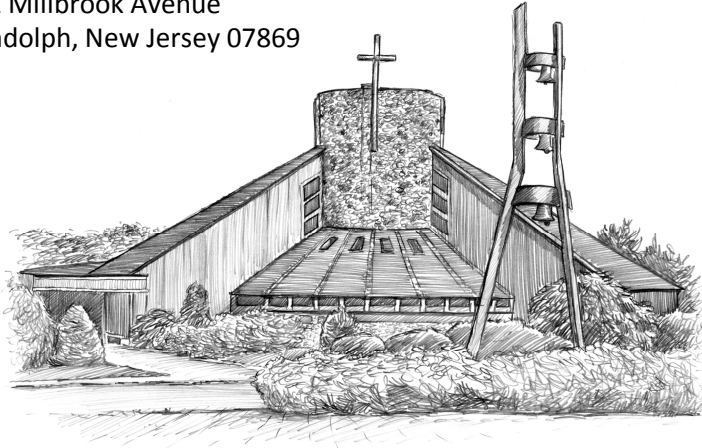

HISTORY, MISSION AND WELCOME

Erected as a parish on July 1, 1978 with Msgr. Martin Rauscher, as founding Pastor, Resurrection Parish's early growth gave rise to another parish in Randolph in 1988, St. Matthew. Through the dedication and generosity of our founding parishioners, the original structure was completed and blessed on October 9, 1983. The Parish has also been blessed by the years of ministry of Pastor Emeritus, Father John Andrew Connell. The building addition was blessed on October 12, 2008.
