

The Parish has also been blessed by the years of ministry of Pastor Emeritus, Father John Andrew Connell. The building addition was blessed on October 12, 2008

Fridays of Lent are days of ABSTINENCE.

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast; by this obligation the individual is permitted only one full meal in the day. From the age of 14, all are obliged to abstain. The law of abstinence forbids eating meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments of any kind even though made from animal fat. The obligation to observe the laws of fast and abstinence "substantially" or as a whole is a serious obligation. Failure to observe any penitential day in itself is <u>not</u> considered serious. It is the failure to observe any penitential days at all, or a substantial number of such days, which is considered serious.
