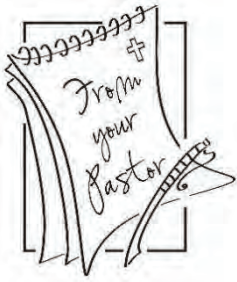

Dear Parish Family,

As we celebrate love, I pray for my sister and brother-in-law, for Ken and Mary Ruth, and for all couples in our

parish, that their witness may inspire many more to embrace the beautiful vocation of holy matrimony.

It is very energizing being with my family, now I feel full of new strength to continue walking with you and strengthening our beautiful spiritual family of Resurrection.

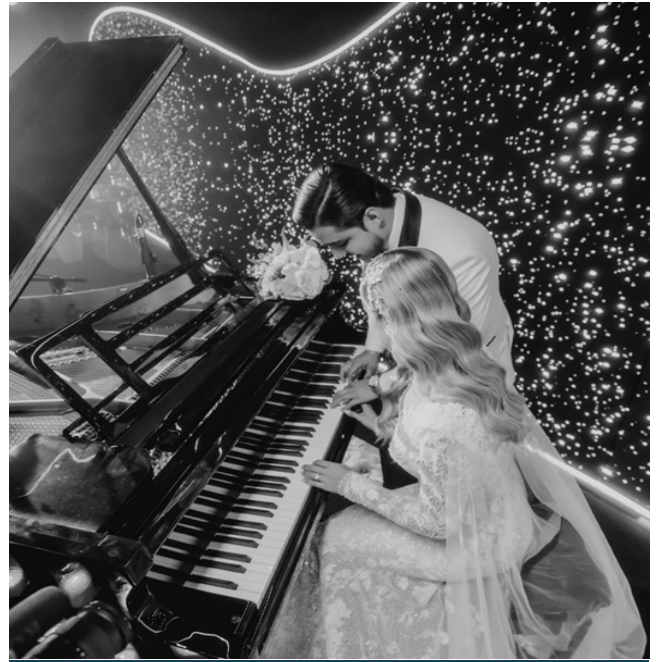
