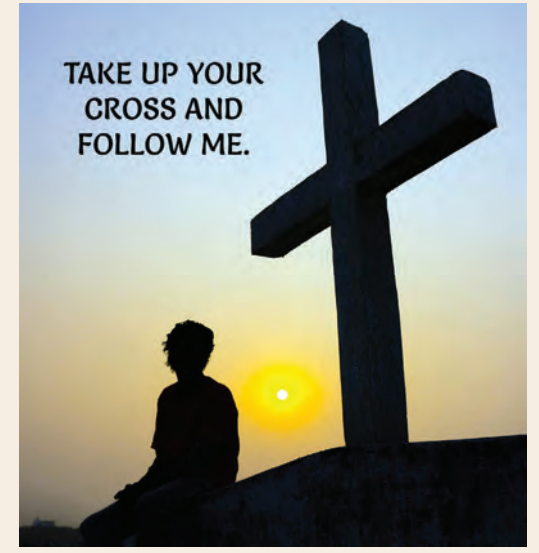

"THE EUCHARIST –

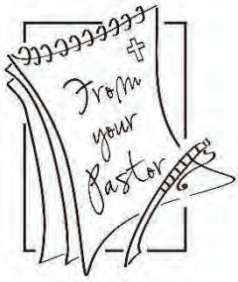
DISCOVERING THE MASS IN THE BIBLE"
