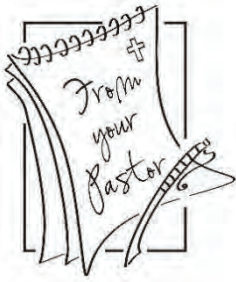
BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP

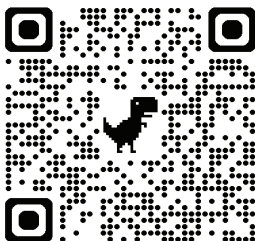
