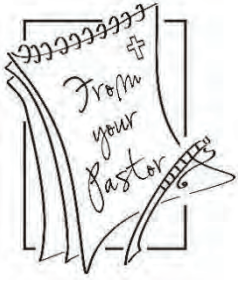

1. Sound System Project & Pilgrimage to Rome

I am so moved by your generosity toward the Sound System Project.

If you are not yet part of this effort, please see the next page of the bulletin for more details. We truly need your help to make this project a reality. We will keep you informed about project's details. I will keep you all in my prayers during my trip to Rome. Even though I have had the blessing of visiting Rome before, this pilgrimage is very special because it is a Jubilee Year, a Holy Year, a Year of Hope. Somethings that happen every 25 years. I will be joining catechists from around the world for the International Pilgrimage of Catechists and will be with our Holy Father, Pope Leo, who is the Church's first catechist. One of his great responsibilities is to teach us through catechesis. Please know that as I visit these holy places, I will be praying for each of you. My prayer always includes the people I have met, the people I know, and the people I will meet and that means all of you are included in the graces of this Jubilee.

2. Blessing of the Animals – October 5 at 1:00 p.m.

We are very excited to celebrate the Blessing of the Animals on Saturday, October 5, at 1:00 p.m. in the upper parking lot. Bob Weingaertner will be bringing some treats for your pets, and he will help lead the special service. I will be there to assist and to offer the blessings for your beloved animals.

3. Confirmation with Bishop Kevin – October 7 at 7:00 p.m.

We cannot wait to welcome our spiritual father, Bishop Kevin Sweeney, on Monday, October 7, at 7:00 p.m. as he comes to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on our teenagers. I spent time with them last Sunday, and together we watched a video encouraging them to share their gifts and talents with the Church. Confirmation is the sacrament of Christian maturity, and these young people are now being sent out as evangelizers to bring the Good News to the world around them. We are so proud of their parents, sponsors, grandparents, and catechists who have walked with them on this journey of faith.

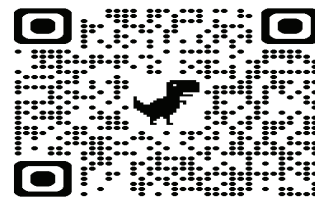
