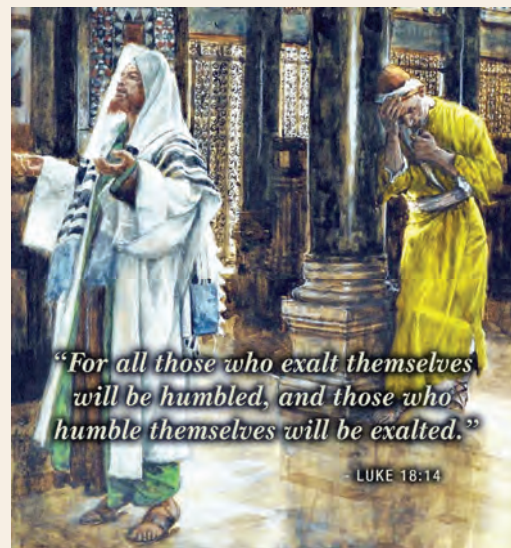

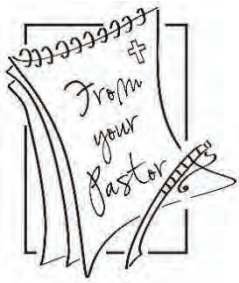

As members of Resurrection Parish since the first Mass at Randolph Intermediate School (now Randolph Middle School), we have tried to serve the parish in whatever ways we could over the years. We are not really the “always volunteering” types, but, usually, if someone asked if we could find the time to do whatever it was, we did. Maybe it the little voice in our heads (the Holy Spirit?) nudging us on. Over the years, one or both of us taught religious education, first, in the parish's home program, then, in the Growing in the Spirit program, ushered, served on the parish's 25th anniversary committee (and various other committees whose names we can't now recall), served in various ways in Samaritans and were collection counters. Our longest involvement has been our more than thirty years as Eucharistic Ministers. Although we never felt worthy of this ministry, we think God wanted us in it, and we thank Him for it. For about twenty years, we have coordinated the liturgical Eucharistic Ministers (i.e. those who serve at Mass) which involves scheduling Eucharistic Ministers for the weekend and holiday Masses. We see our service to the parish over the years as a blessing to us and our family because they learned by example that serving other is important. We feel that we have become better people and have grown stronger in our faith as a result of our encounters with all the amazing people who have been part our Resurrection Parish experience. Although coming to Mass is most important, really feeling part of the church community comes from getting involved in other ways. Resurrection Parish has always been filled with many good and wonderful people worshipping the Lord and serving His people. May it continue to be so.

Samaritans coordinates our **RaiseRight** program, where you can purchase shopping cards for a wide variety of companies. **For every shopping card purchased, Samaritans receives a rebate that is used to help those in need.** The percentage for the rebate varies by vendor. You are able to spend the full value of your purchase when using any of these shopping cards. The RaiseRight table in the Narthex is available around Masses to purchase cards from inventory, to order cards for pick up the following weekend, or to pick up prior orders. Physical shopping cards usually available from inventory include Shoprite, ACME, WEIS, Stop & Shop, Dunkin, Panera, Starbucks, Amazon, QuickChek, Wawa, and VISA cards (with no activation fee), among others. Many more vendors are available for order. If there's a particular card you'd like available in inventory, feel free to contact Tammy. In addition to physical gift cards, some vendors offer e-cards, as well as a RELOAD option in some cases. The program includes a couple of different payment options. There is an online portal, as well as a mobile app for those who prefer to do as much as possible electronically. Orders can be shipped directly to you, if you prefer, for some vendors. **It is a way to help others while making your regular purchases.**

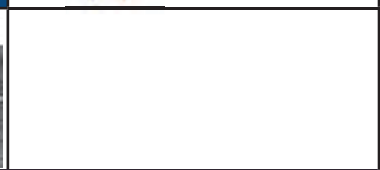
