RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (R.C.I.A.)

I love what the Lord Jesus has given to His Catholic Church – the fullness of all that He has revealed to the human family. All the teachings, all the truths, all the sacraments, all the traditions, all the devotions – I love it all. And I love to teach others about what I love. That's why as a priest one of my favorite things is teaching RCIA.

The RCIA is the process by which the Church initiates new members into the fullness of communion that is the Catholic Church:

- The unbaptized one will be baptized, confirmed and fed with the Eucharist and begin living the Catholic following of Jesus Christ.
- Those baptized but not Catholic one will be received into the life of the Catholic Church through a Profession of Faith, be confirmed and be fed with the Eucharist and begin living the Catholic following of Jesus Christ.
- Those Catholics not yet confirmed one will be confirmed and now with fullness of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit live out their Catholic following of Jesus Christ.

Are you interested? Do you know someone else who is but who would never read this bulletin to know of this opportunity?

RCIA is a time of learning, prayer, and deepening one's relationship with God through all that He gives us in His Son Jesus Christ and in His Church. There is so much to know – and then live – in our Catholic faith life. The Catholic faith and the teachings of Christ in His Church can be so unknown and so misunderstood – here is a chance to have them made known and understood to those who are being so drawn.

Does a person have to become Catholic if they begin coming to RCIA sessions? NO! But many people do, once the fullness of the Catholic life is laid before them and the gifts from the Lord God that comes with it are offered to them. But that will be up to the person who comes – I've had many folks in my years who attended all the sessions, enjoyed them and learned much . . . but couldn't make that step and become Catholics themselves. However the Lord calls and whatever He calls us to – His will, not ours, right? But this is a great chance to "come and see" as Jesus invited His first apostles to do.

The RCIA year begins on September 8 and will finish up on May 4. The sessions will be on Thursday evenings from 7:00 – 9:00 pm in the St Catherine Conference Room in the parish office building. (Of course there will be a few breaks with holidays and some of the Thursdays I will need to be away.) In all, there are 27 sessions – yes, that's a lot – but there's a lot to the Catholic life. And you will enjoy and appreciate it – trust me.

Spread the word about this to people whom you think might be open to this. You all know the folks around here a lot better than I ever will. For those who are not presently Catholic but are married to one . . . a special invitation to come is yours. It's good to know what your Catholic spouse is up to and why!

Contact me if planning on attending – and even if you don't, show up that first night if you decide to at the last minute! It's important to come to all of the sessions, so don't miss out on the first one.
