



## Pastor's Page

#### **BEGINNING EXPERIENCE**

I was ordained in 1990 (my 35th anniversary will be next month . . . oh my) - and Msgr. Wendelyn Vetter was my one and only mentor pastor during my two years as a Parochial Vicar at St Anthony's in Fargo. Msgr. Vetter was heavily involved with a ministry I had never heard of before: Beginning Experience. He had learned about it many years before, and had brought it to the Diocese of Fargo and was the head-shed with that program in our diocese for decades. (The first confessions I heard as a priest - a week after I arrived at St. Anthony's - was at a Beginning Experience weekend in Fargo - I will never forget how worn out I was after that first experience of administering that sacrament.)

Msgr. Vetter passed away, but the Beginning Experience program has continued, and it has a weekend coming up in June. "BE" (as it is called) is a program for those who are widowed, separated, or divorced. They have experienced an enormous amount of grief in their loss and this one weekend can sometimes make all the difference to get that healing process started that they so much need.

There are some brochures in the narthex of our church on that long table - if you, or someone you know, might be just the person who could use some of that healing and comfort in that kind of loss, get that brochure, read more about it, and take it in. It is not only for Catholics, but it certainly has a Christian bent, and there is a priest there for the weekend.

Every one of us is a wounded soul in some way, aren't we? BE helps those individuals in their woundedness. It is a wonderful program.

Happy Mother's Day to all the mothers in our parish! It certainly is a special day - *because mothers are special*. May you have a blessed day and know the love of those you have born and nurtured - and also the love of those you may not have born but still nurtured as a mother does!

Cardinal Francis George was the Archbishop of Chicago many years ago - he passed away in 2015. He was a very holy man - a wonderful shepherd for that big archdiocese. I ran across a quote from him recently, and thought I would share it with you. He was gathered in a room full of wealthy people (there are lots of them out there in Chicago), and he said:

"The poor need you to draw them out of poverty, and you need the poor to keep you out of hell."

Youch! That could sting a bit, couldn't it? But Cardinal George, as usual, had something important to say. For the most of us, let us never take for granted how richly Our Lord has gifted us.

As you read this I will have turned the corner on my week away and heading back to our city in the valley. I'll be back in the parish on Monday evening, and ready to go with daily Mass on Tuesday . . . and with two sems with us for the next 8 weeks!






#### Rosary Walk Project


